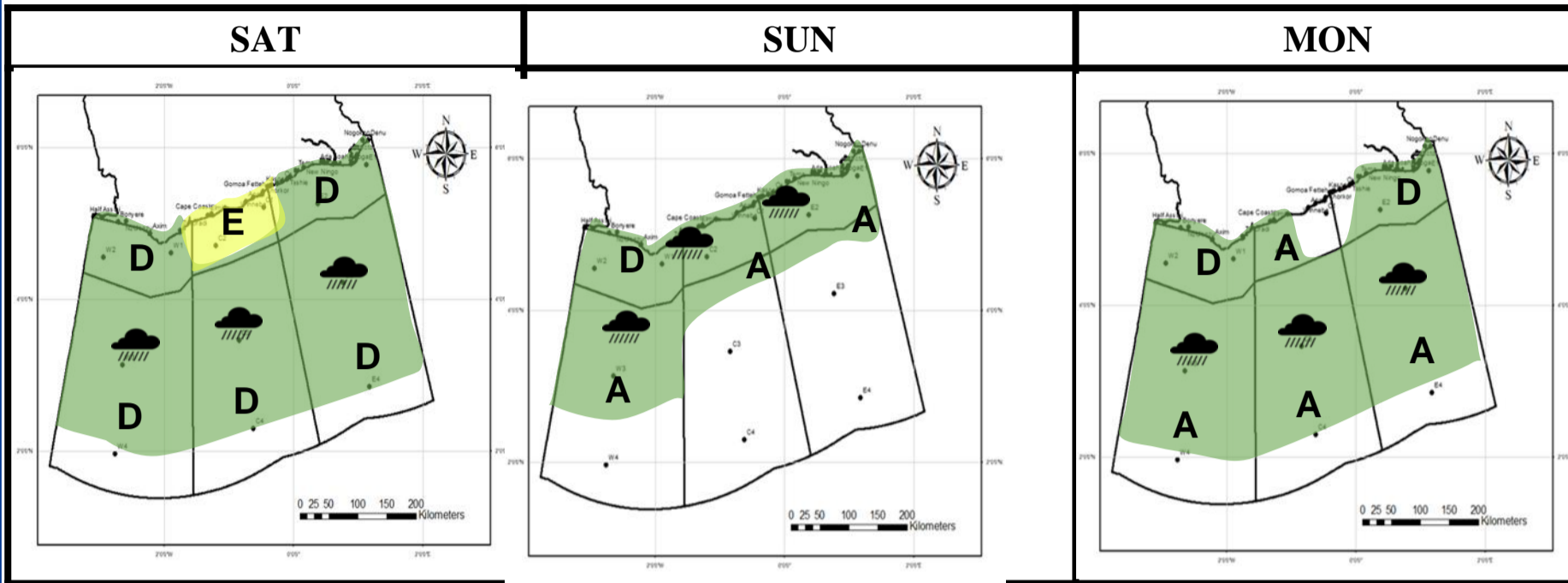

The state of the sea will be calm on Saturday, with a gradual increase in wave height leading to rough conditions later.
