

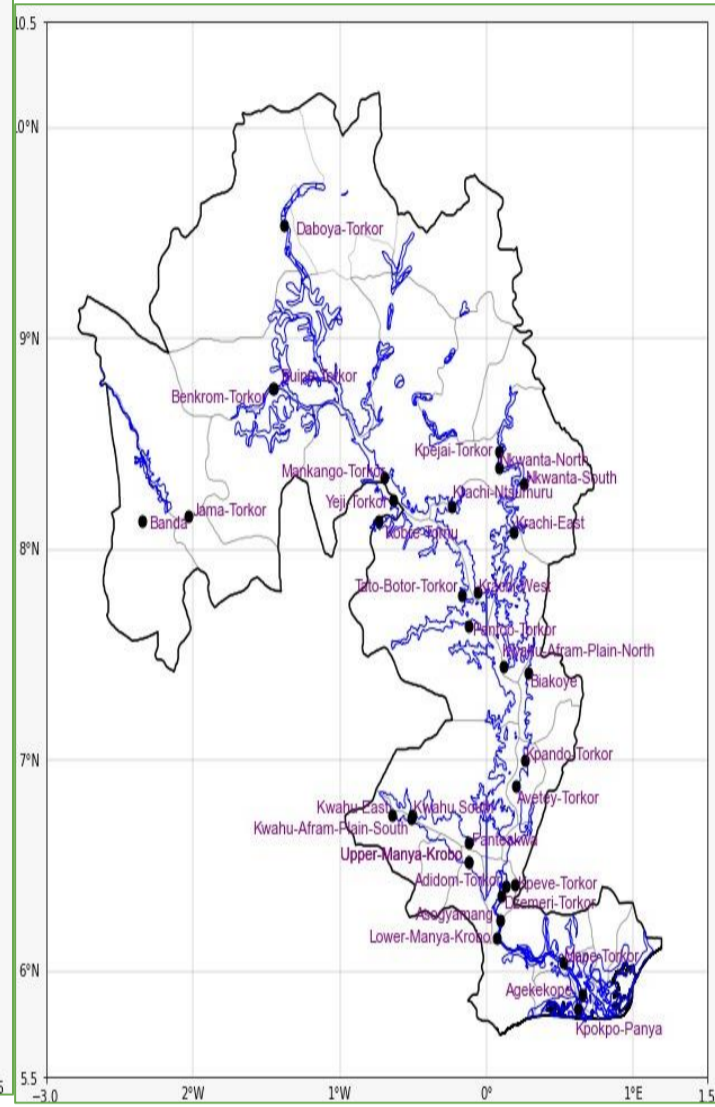
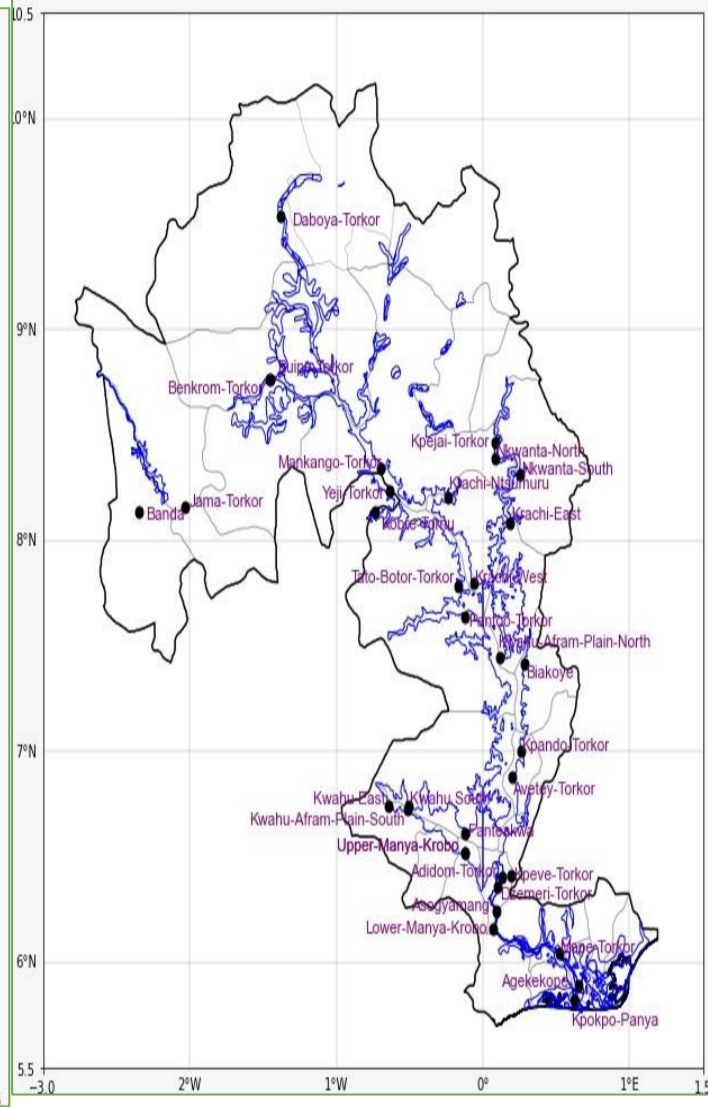
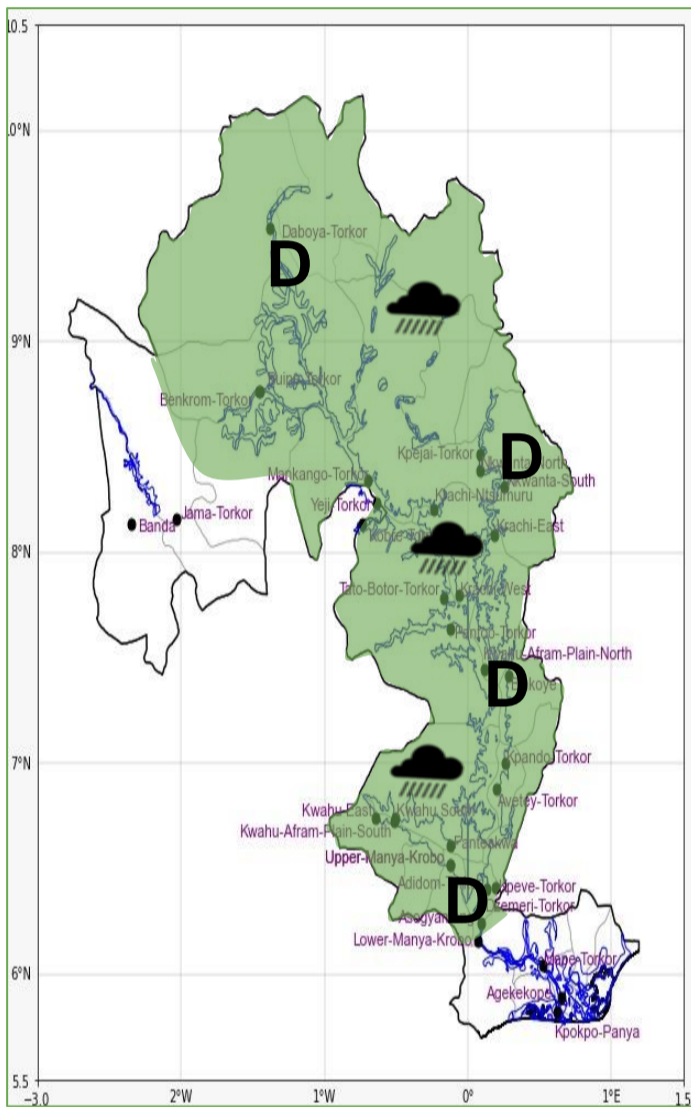


INLAND WATER IMPACT-BASED FORECAST

WEATHER SUMMARY

Tonight, the northern half of the lake will be mostly cloudy, while the southern half will experience variable cloud cover. Thunderstorms and rain with a 40% chance are expected in some parts of the northern, middle, and southern sectors during the first few hours of the evening. By the early hours of the morning, mist is expected to reduce visibility over forested and hilly areas.
