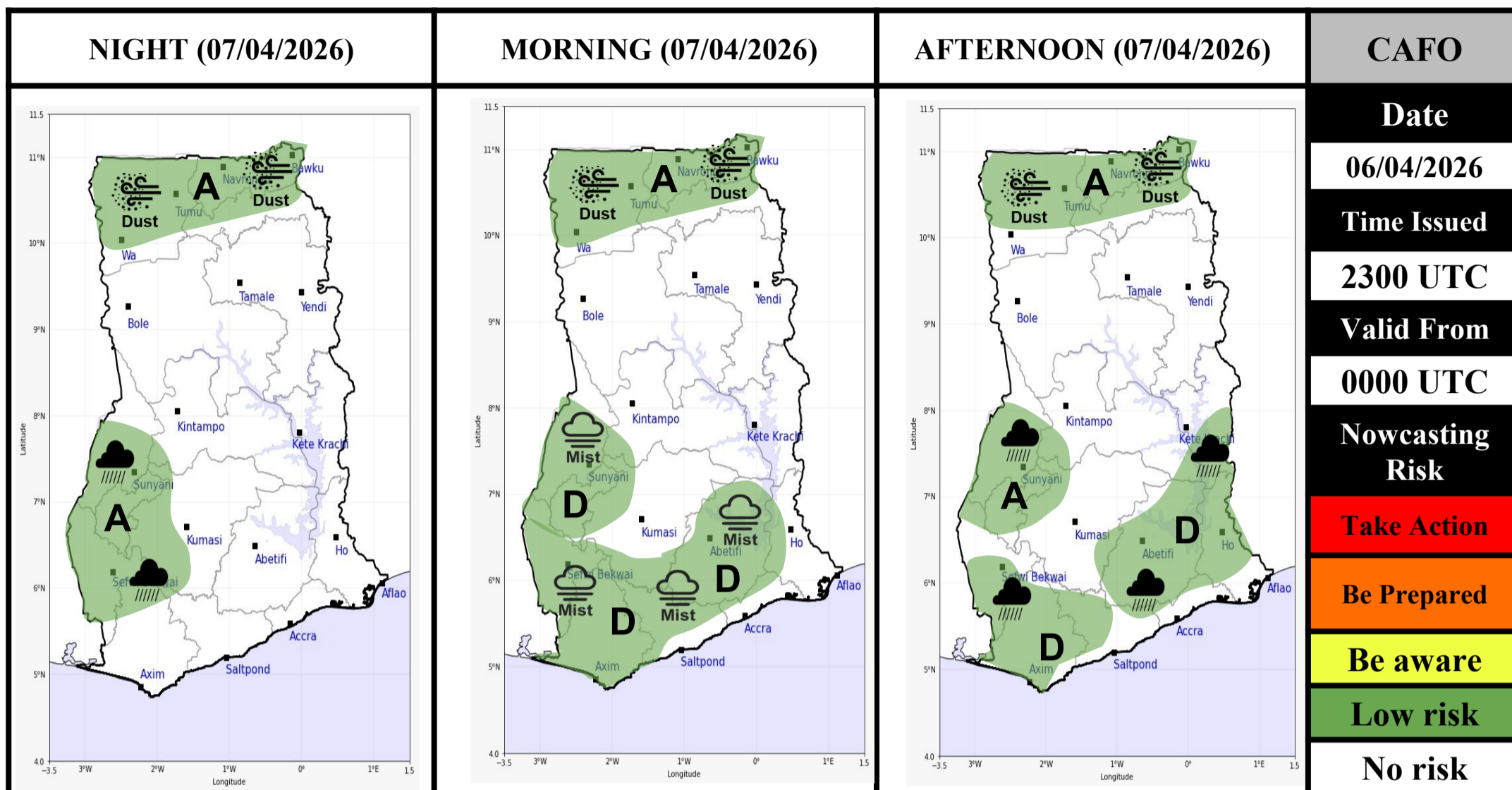

SUMMARY: Partly cloudy skies are expected to dominate most parts of the country throughout the night with a few cases of rain within the middle sector. Northern Ghana will remain mostly clear, with few cloud formation and slightly hazy conditions across the upper regions. As the night progresses into the early morning hours, mist or fog is likely to form over the forest belt and hilly areas.
