

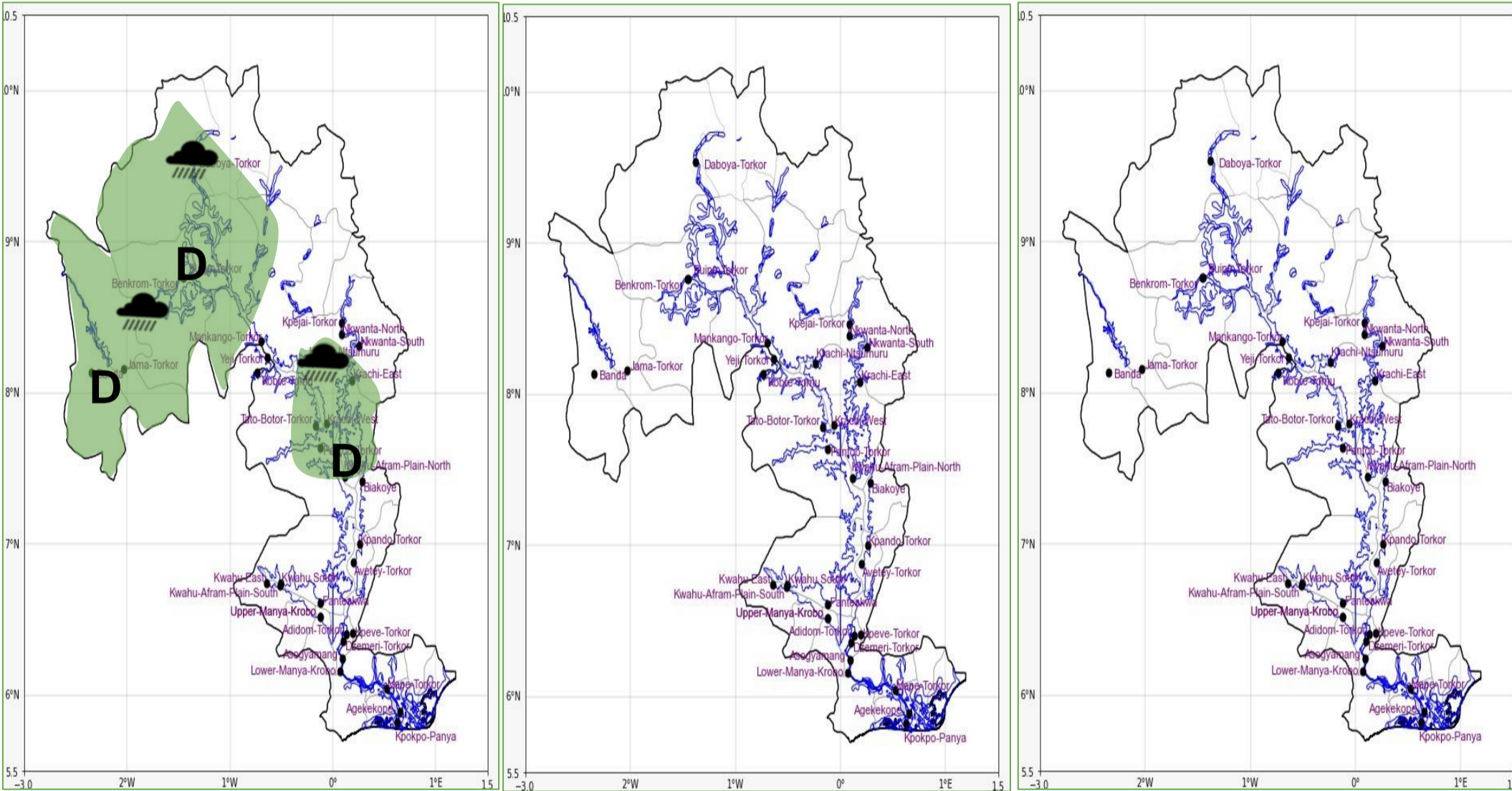


INLAND WATER IMPACT-BASED FORECAST

WEATHER SUMMARY

The northern half of the lake is expected to be mostly cloudy tonight, while the southern half will remain variably cloudy. There is a 40% chance of isolated thunderstorms and rain over the northern sector in the evening, spreading to the middle portions later in the night. Early morning visibility is expected to be reduced by mist over hilly and vegetated areas.
