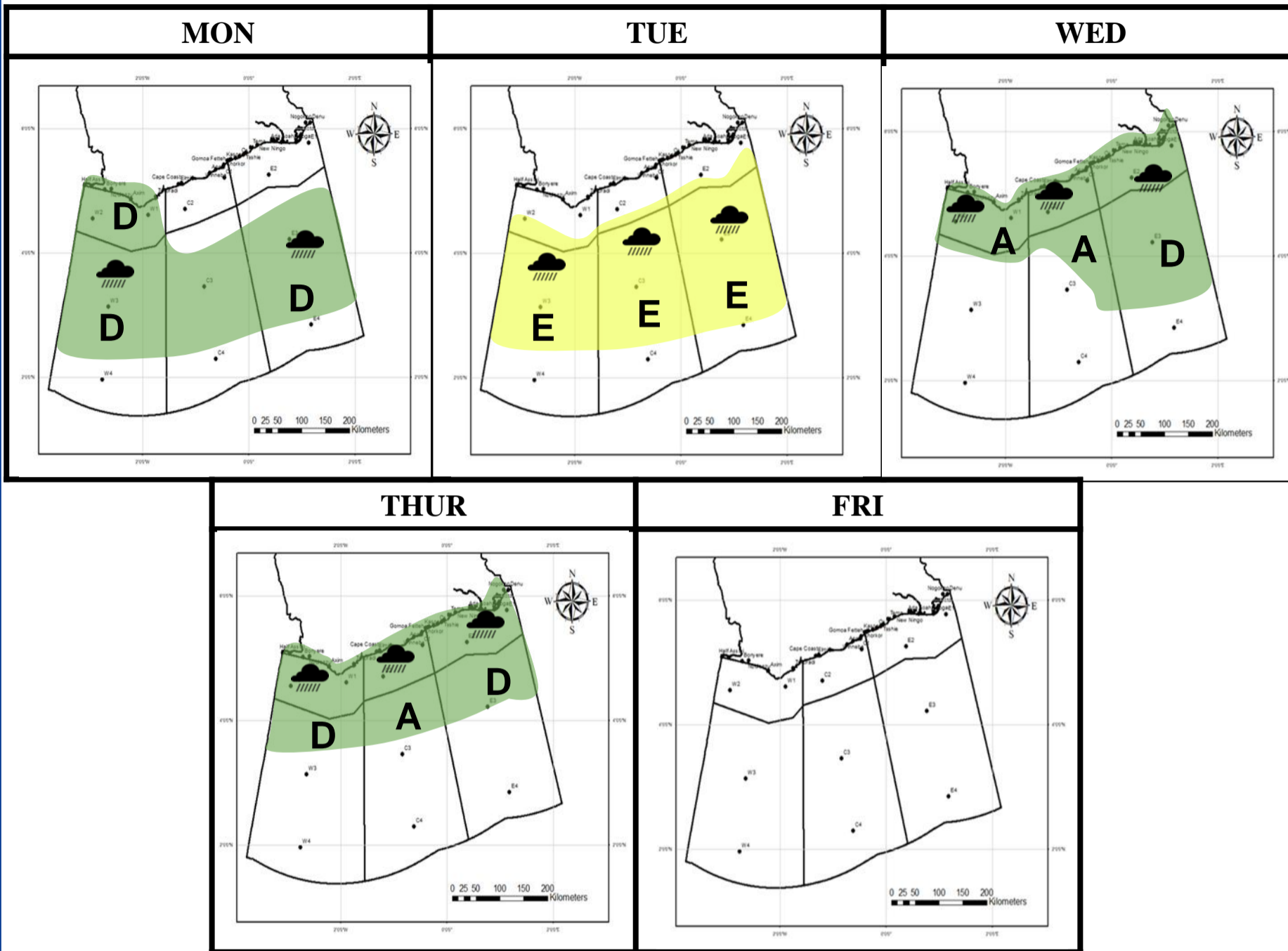

### WEATHER SUMMARY

Throughout the forecast period, variable cloud cover is expected, with some sunshine likely in the afternoon. There is a 30% to 60% chance of isolated light to moderate rainfall and thunderstorms affecting both onshore and offshore areas. Additionally, rough sea conditions are anticipated throughout the week.

**NB: Strong winds are anticipated across the marine areas this week, particularly along the east coast.**
