



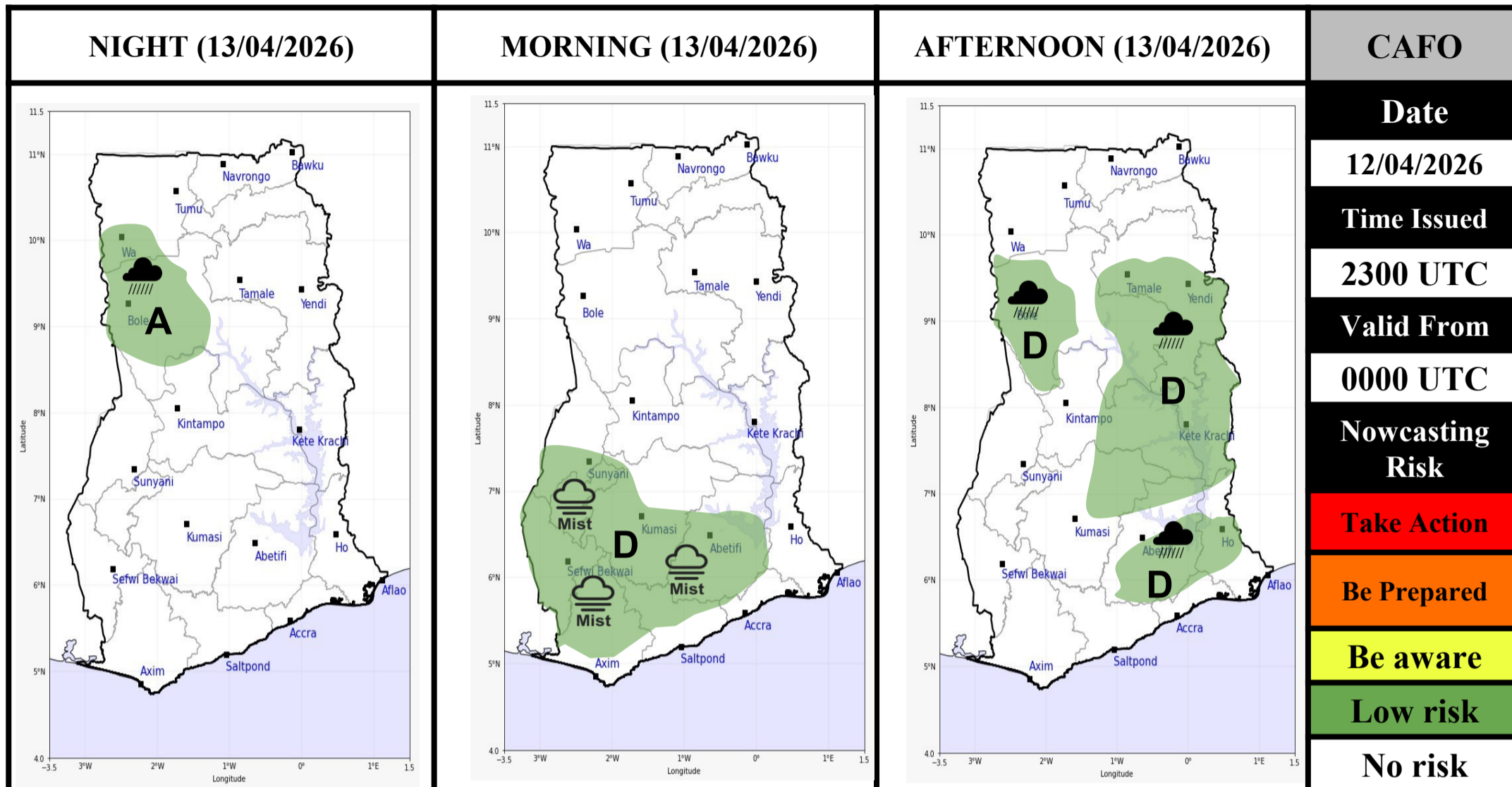

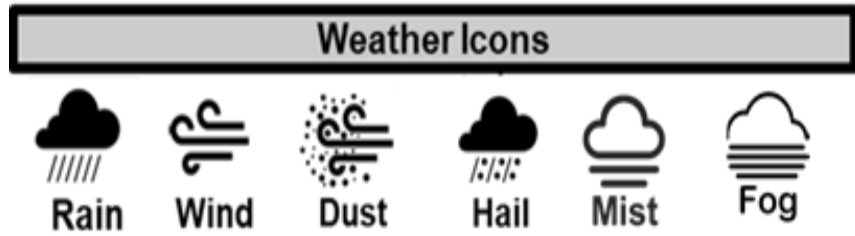
## 24-HOUR IMPACT-BASED FORECAST FOR GHANA

**SUMMARY:** Partly cloudy conditions will persist over most parts of the country with chances of rainfall likely over very few places within the savannah region during the night hours. Early morning mist or patches of fog are expected over parts of the forest and mountainous areas as well. As the day progresses into the afternoon, sunny conditions will prevail across the country with thunderstorms or rain affecting some places within the north, transition and middle sectors.
