



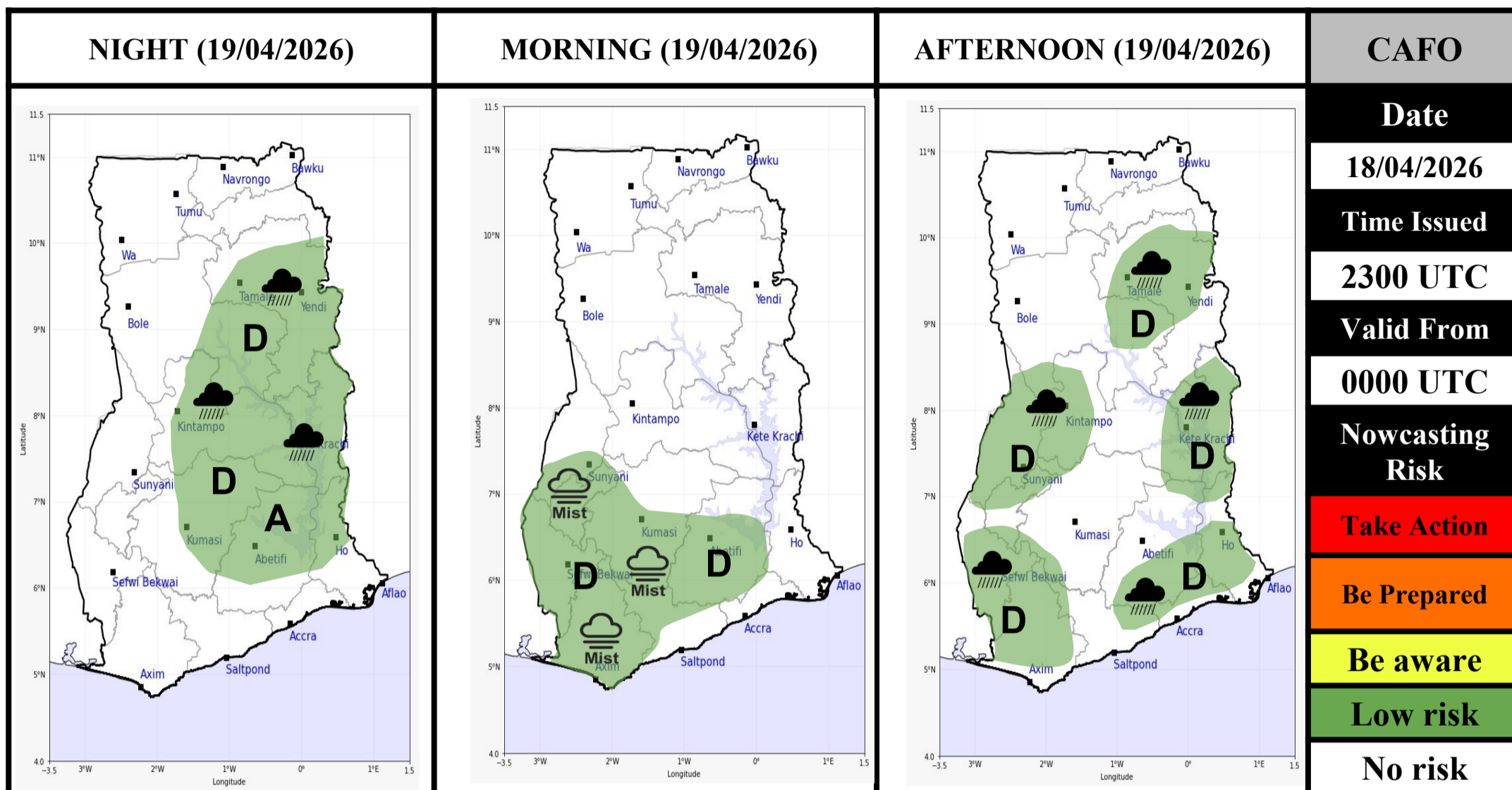

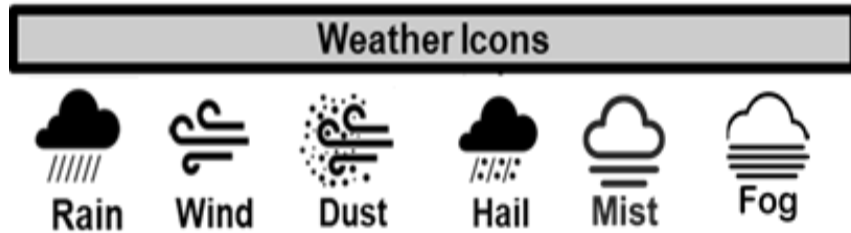
## 24-HOUR IMPACT-BASED FORECAST FOR GHANA

**SUMMARY:** Thunderstorms or rain are expected over few areas within the middle, transition and northern sectors of the country overnight. Mist or fog patches are likely to develop over hilly and forest zones during the early morning hours. Sunny weather will prevail across most places in the country as the day progresses into the afternoon, with thunderstorms or rain anticipated over parts of the middle, transition and northern sectors from late afternoon hours into the evening.
