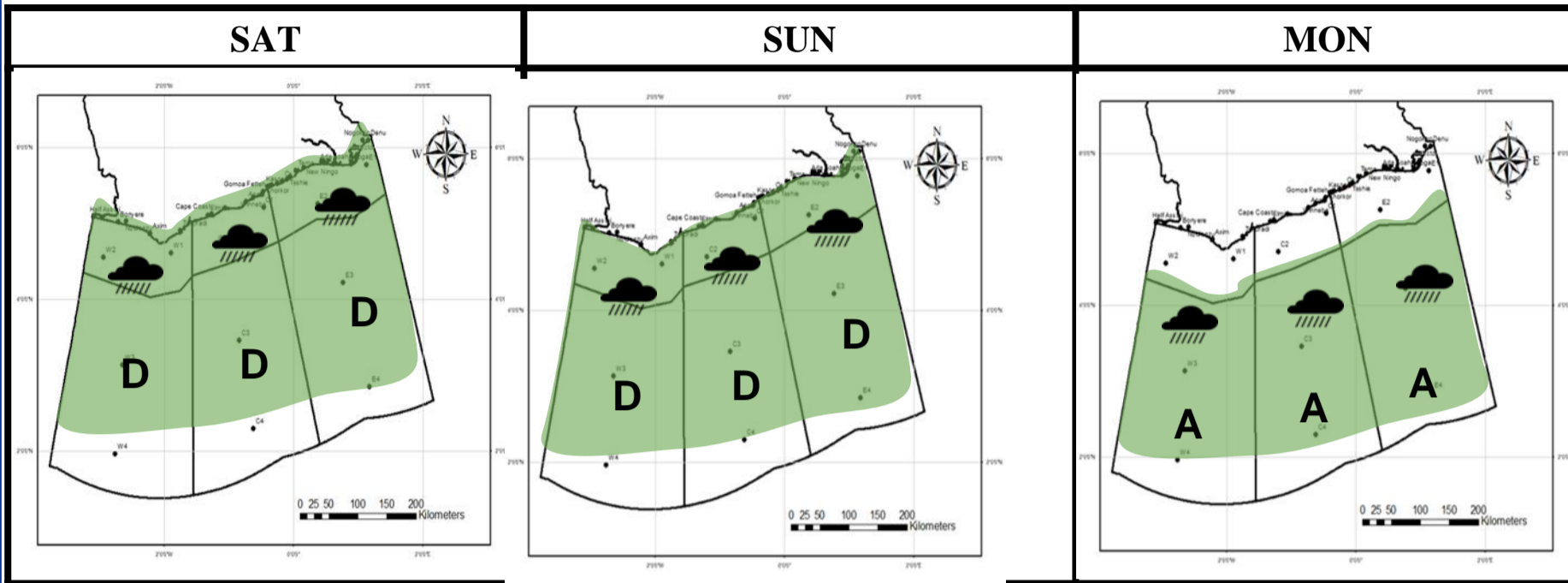

WEATHER SUMMARY

Throughout the forecast period, the nation's marine areas are anticipated to experience variable cloud cover, with intermittent afternoon sunshine. Nonetheless, there is a 30–60% chance of scattered light to moderate rain and thunderstorms accompanied by strong winds both onshore and offshore. During this period, rough sea states are expected.
