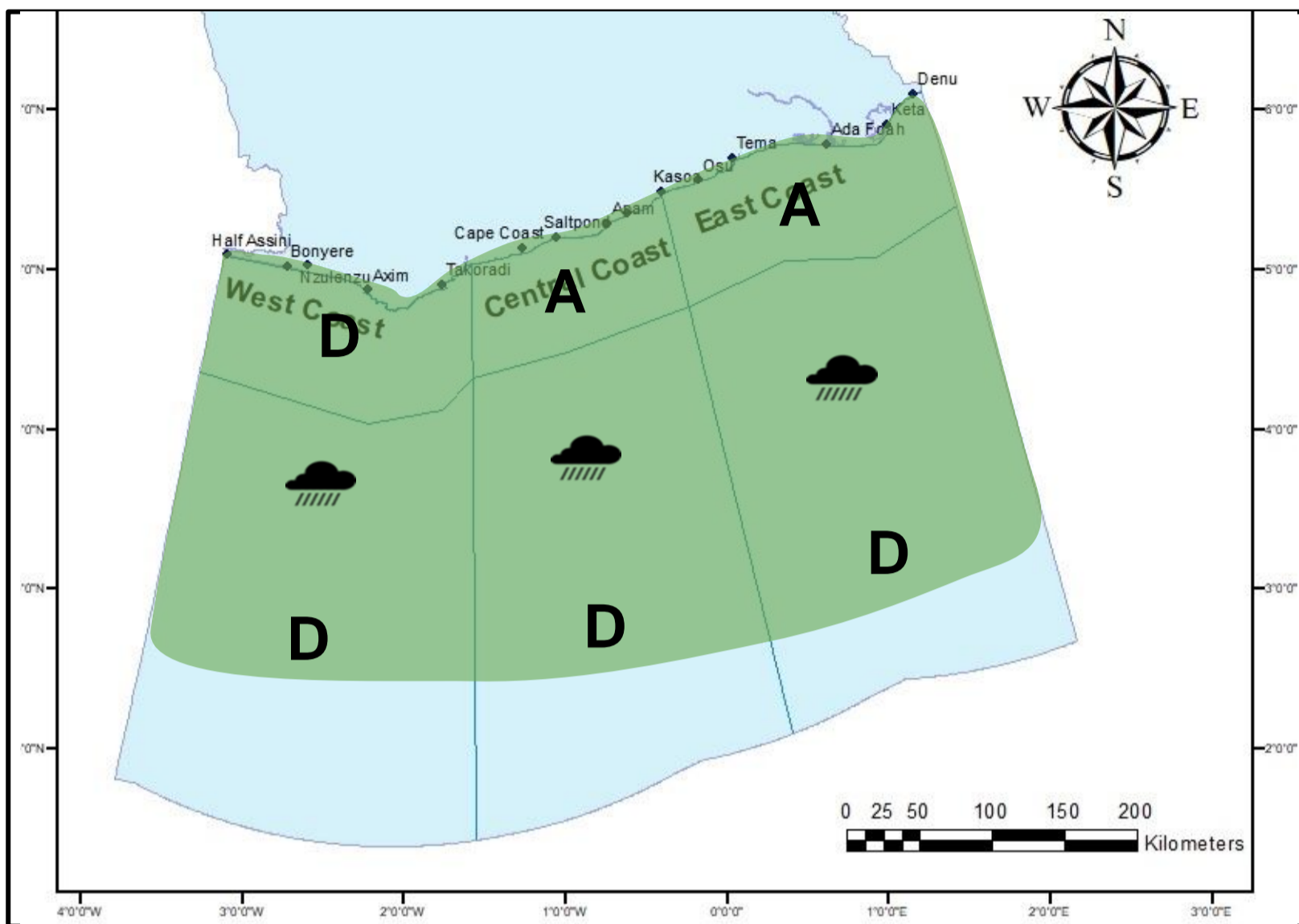

WEATHER: The country's maritime space is expected to experience predominantly cloudy weather conditions throughout the forecast period, with occasional sunshine in the afternoon. However, isolated light to moderate rain and thunderstorms, with a 30-40% probability of occurrence, are anticipated over areas onshore and offshore between this afternoon and the evening.

NB: Strong winds and very rough seas are expected across the marine space during the validity period.
