SUMMARY: Mist or fog patches are expected over mountainous and forest zones during the early hours of the morning amidst partly cloudy conditions. As the day progresses, periods of sunshine and clouds will alternate over most parts of the country during the afternoon hours with rainfall activities likely over many places within the coastal, middle, transition and northern sectors from late afternoon into the night hours.
