



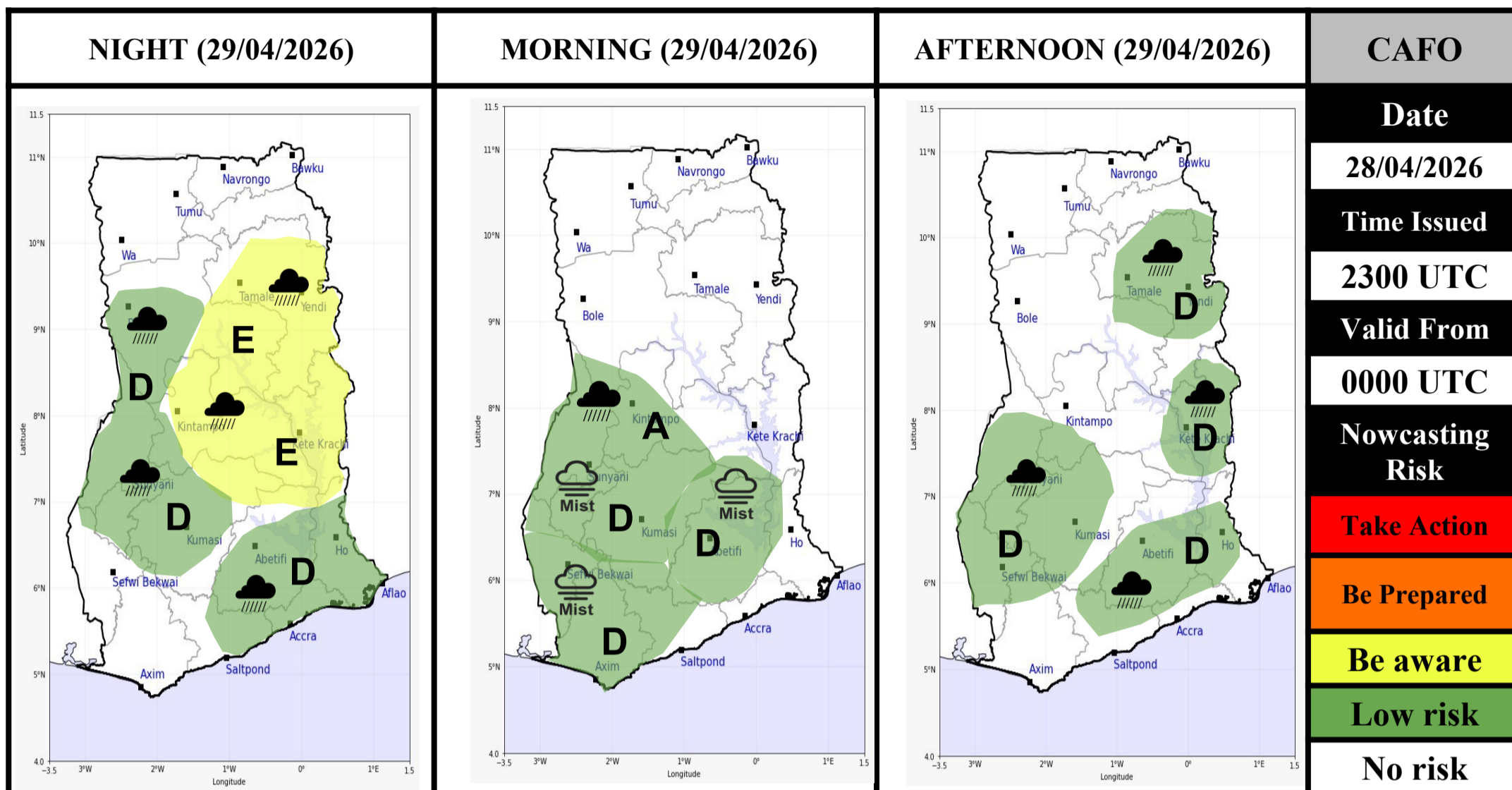

**SUMMARY:** Mostly cloudy conditions will dominate across all sectors of the country tonight with thunderstorms or rain of varying intensity expected along parts of the coastline and the middle sectors. However, the rain bearing clouds currently producing thunderstorms with or without rain over parts of the transition and northern sectors are expected to persist and spread to other areas within these sectors overnight. Mist or fog patches are likely to develop over mountainous and forest zones during the early morning hours. As the day advances into the afternoon, sunny weather with periodic cloudiness with prevail across much of the country with rain and thundery activities anticipated over some towns within the middle, transition and northern sectors.
