



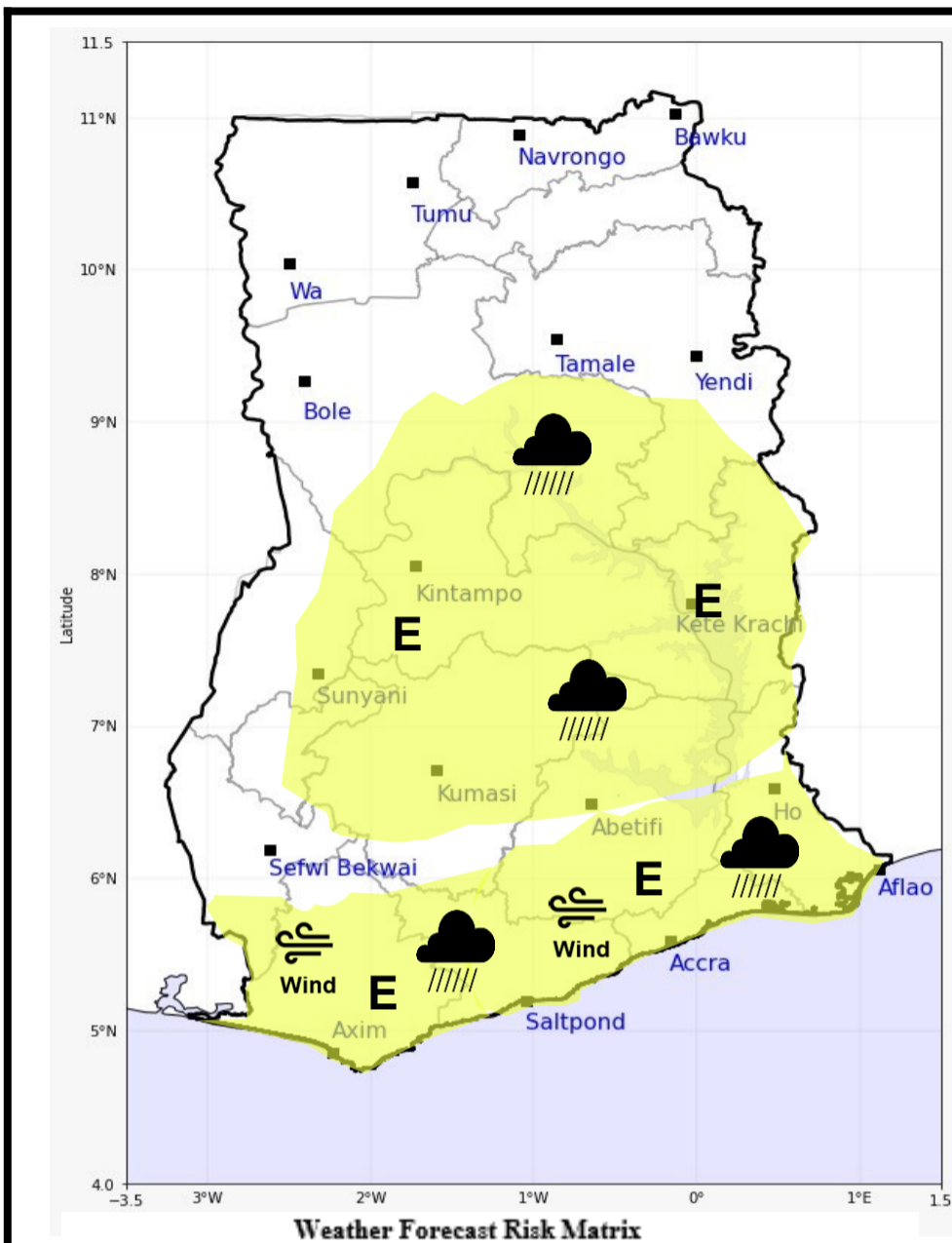

SUMMARY
