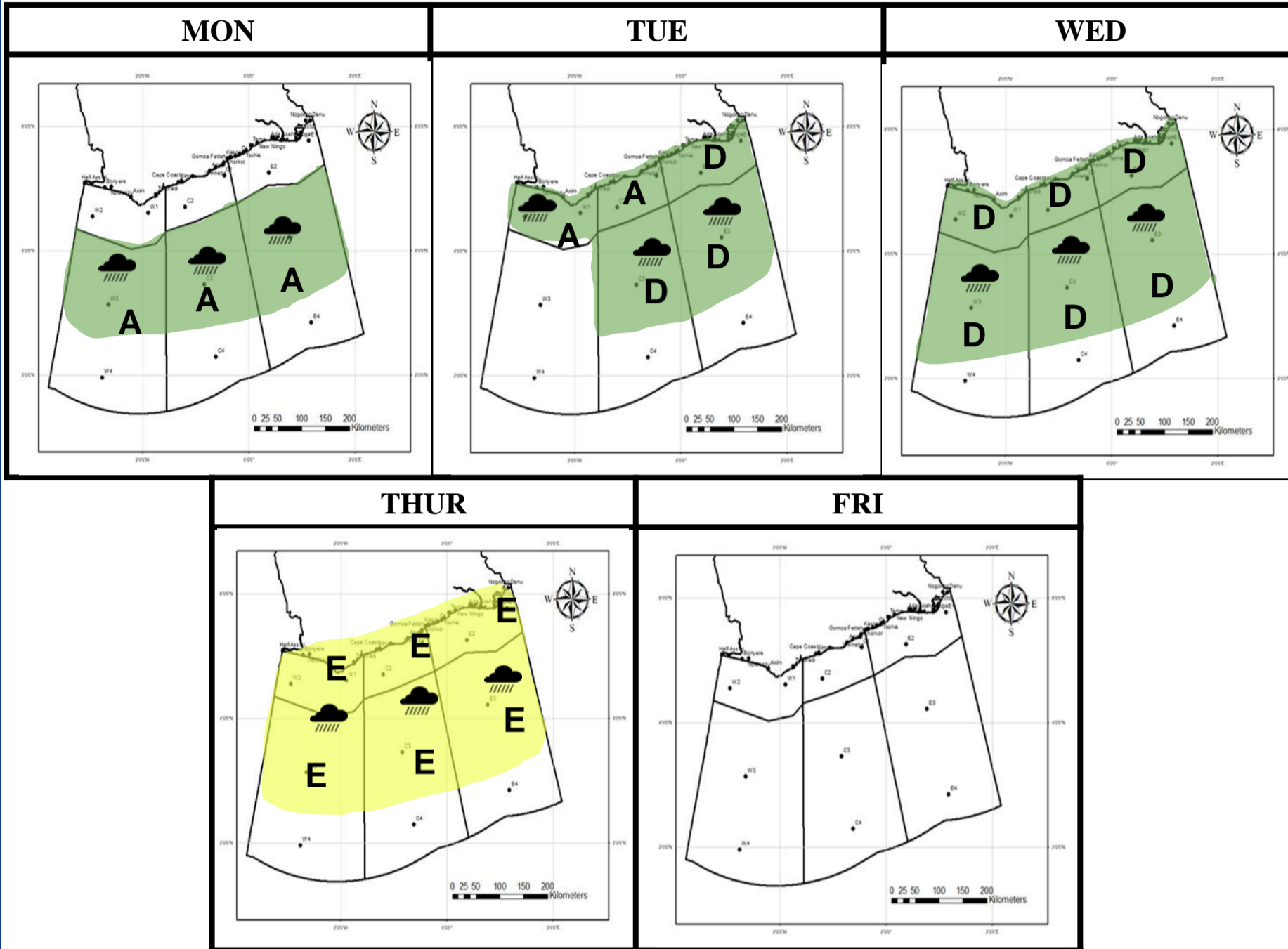

WEATHER SUMMARY

The maritime space is expected to be variably cloudy with occasional sunshine throughout the forecast period. The sea state is expected to remain rough throughout the forecast period.
