

# **⚠️ ALERT: Rainstorm Expected over Southern Ghana**

## **Description:**

A rainstorm observed off the coast of Togo has entered the Volta region of Ghana and is tracking westward, where it is expected to bring rain of varying intensity to the Volta, Eastern, and Greater Accra regions this afternoon. Aflao, Akatsi, Dzodze, Ho, Sogakope, Anloga, Keta and their surroundings are anticipated to be affected first between 1:30 PM and 3:00 PM, followed by Koforidua, Ada Foah, Asesewa, Sege and environs between 2:00 PM and 4:00 PM, with Ashaiman, Accra, Nsawam, Akwatia and surrounding areas expected to experience similar conditions between 2:30 PM and 5:00 PM

**Instruction:**

Residents in the affected and anticipated areas are urged to exercise caution and remain alert as the storm progresses. People are advised to stay indoors where possible, avoid low-lying and flood-prone areas, and refrain from sheltering under trees or in open spaces during periods of thunder and lightning. Motorists should drive carefully due to reduced visibility and potentially slippery road surfaces, while farmers and outdoor workers are encouraged to seek shelter immediately upon the onset of rainfall. Keep following the Ghana Meteorological Agency for updates.
