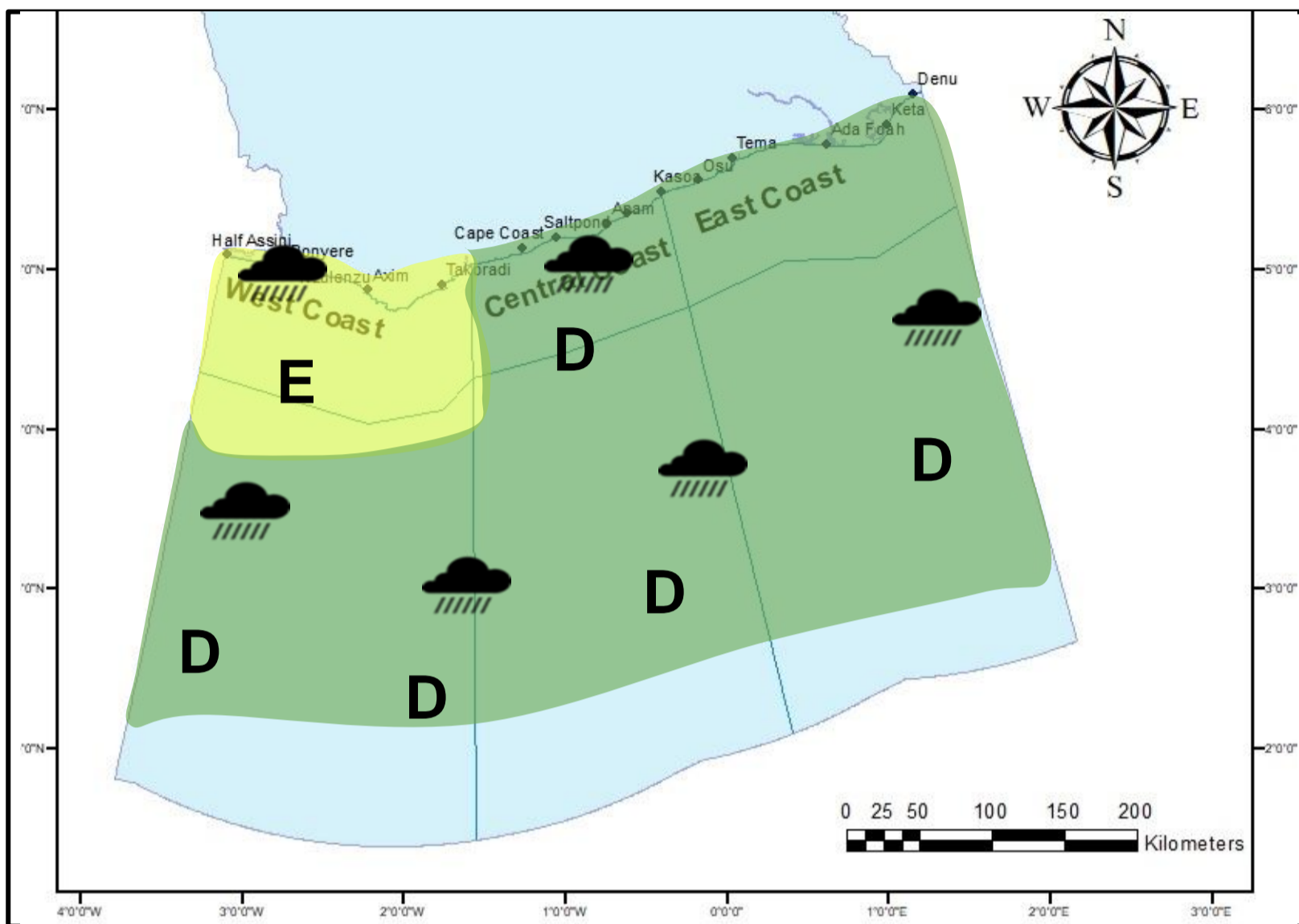

WEATHER: The marine area is expected to experience some sunshine along the central and eastern coasts this afternoon, while the western and offshore regions remain mostly cloudy. Light to moderate thunderstorms with rain are expected across much of the area, particularly in the west and offshore zones. During these storms, wave heights are forecast to increase, leading to very rough sea conditions.
