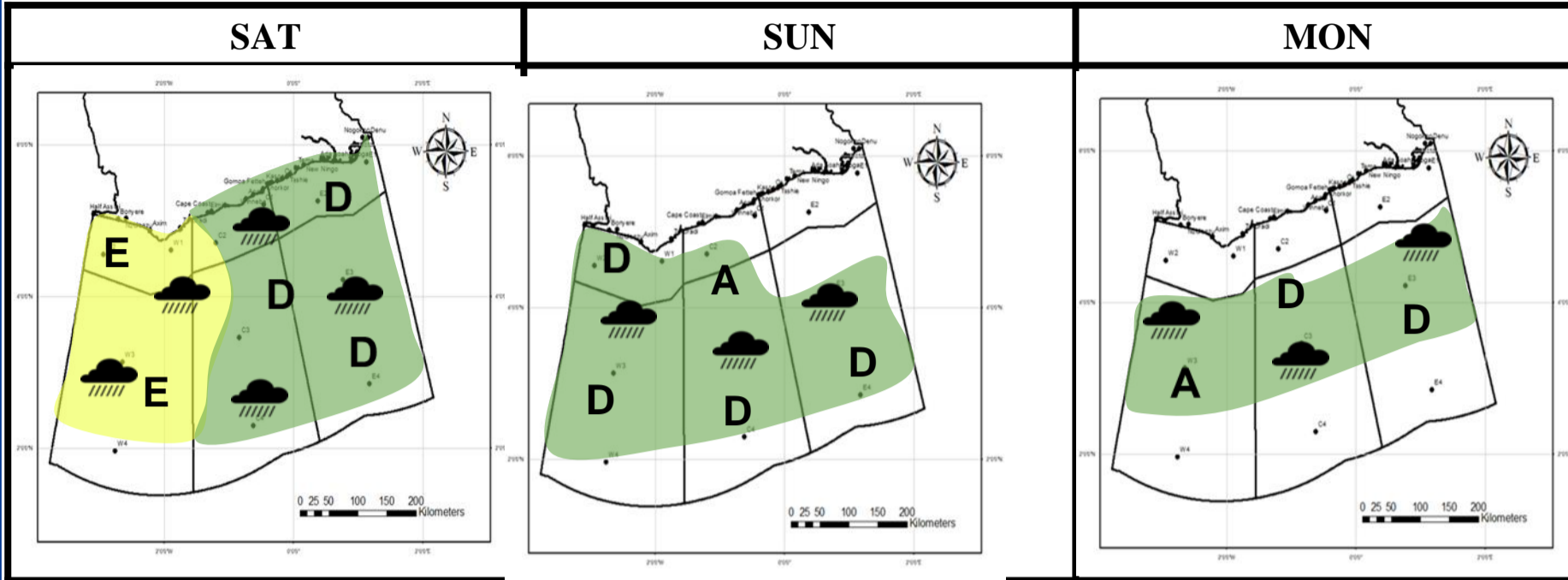

WEATHER SUMMARY

Expect partly to variably cloudy conditions, with sunny spells developing along coastal areas during the afternoons throughout the forecast period. There is also a 40% chance of isolated to scattered thunderstorms across the marine area. Wave heights are forecast to remain elevated, resulting in rough sea conditions through the weekend, before easing slightly by Monday.
