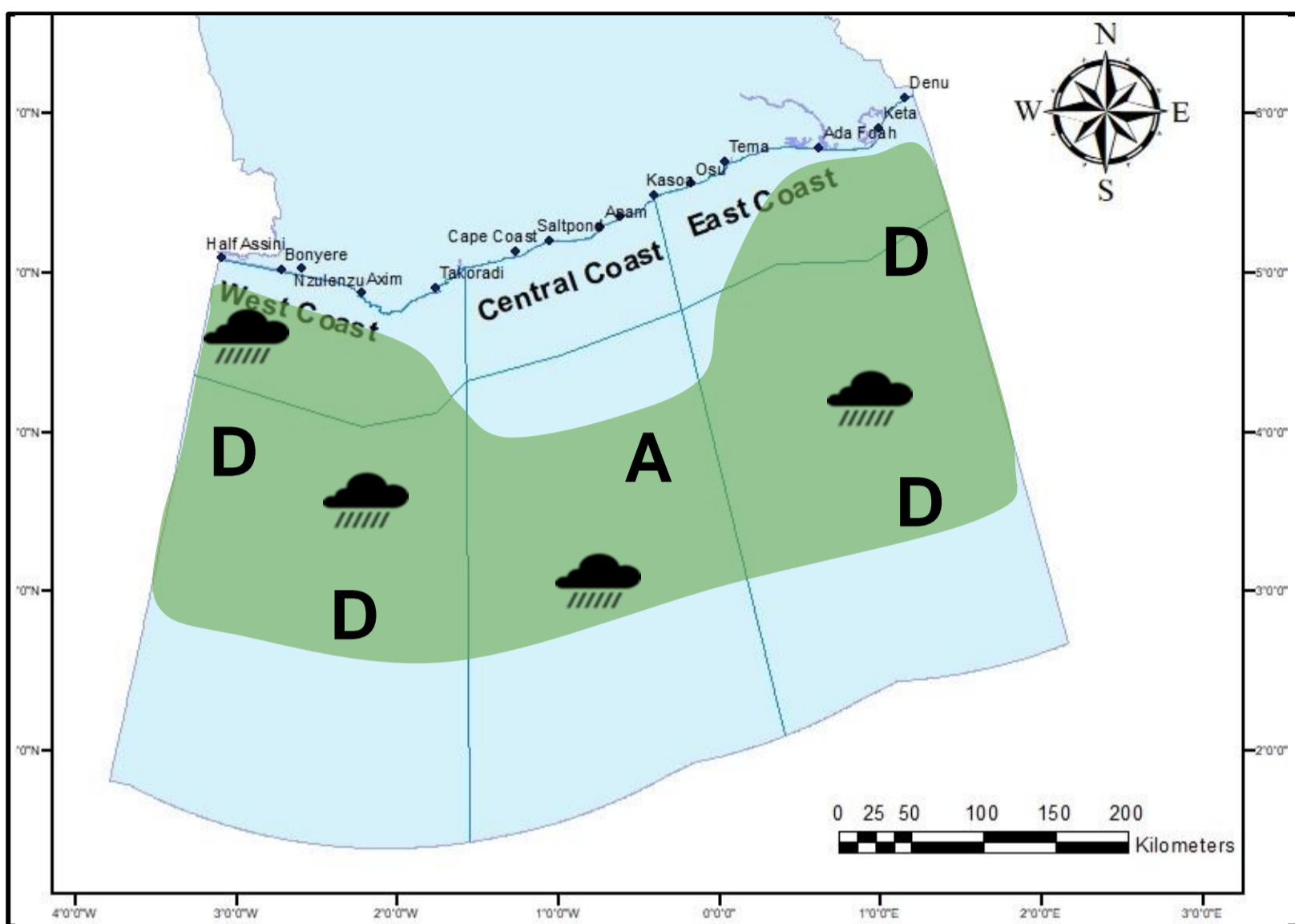

WEATHER SUMMARY: Brief sunshine is expected across the coastlines this afternoon, becoming cloudy later in the evening. Meanwhile, clouds are 40% likely to develop into isolated light to moderate rainfall with thunder over the east coast, west coast, and the offshore region throughout the afternoon.

NB: Sailors are advised to be cautious of gusty winds expected along the east coast from the afternoon into the evening (1600–2100 UTC), with speeds reaching up to about 20 knots.
