WEATHER: Expect variable cloud cover across the marine space from midnight through the afternoon, with a 60% chance of clouds developing into thunderstorms with rain from midnight over the east coast, gradually moving offshore and spreading westward, reducing in intensity, and reaching the west coast by the afternoon.

Sailors are cautioned against gusty winds of about 20KT, which is likely to result in slight to moderate occasional white horses over offshore areas in the early hours of the morning, along with reduced visibility.
