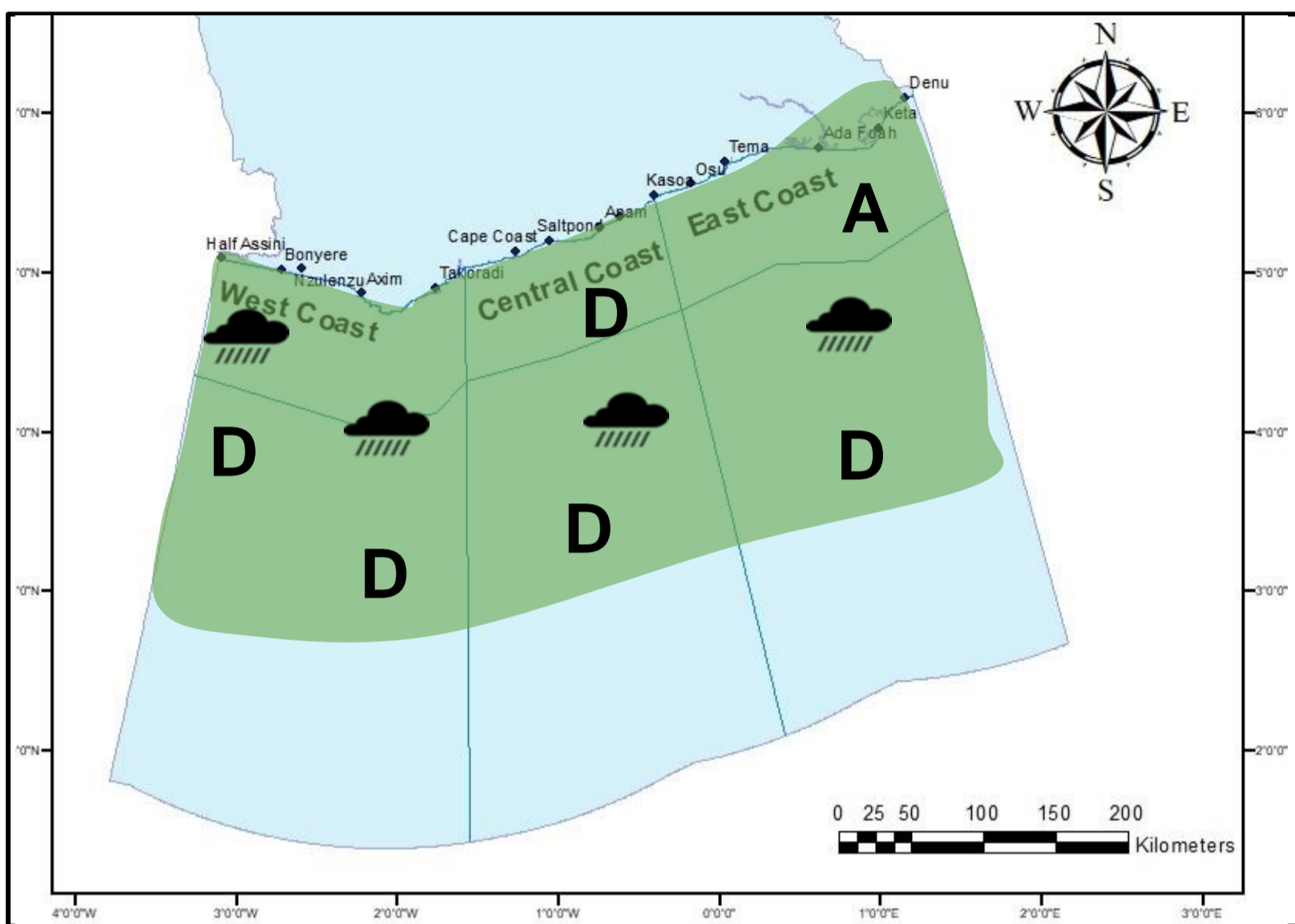

WEATHER SUMMARY: Mostly cloudy conditions are expected across the marine area this afternoon, becoming partly cloudy by evening. The thunderstorm currently over the East Coast is forecast to gradually move westward across the Central Coast and adjacent offshore areas, reaching the West Coast by evening and producing rainfall of varying intensity along its path. Also, gusty winds are expected over offshore areas, producing occasional light to moderate white horses during the storm period.
