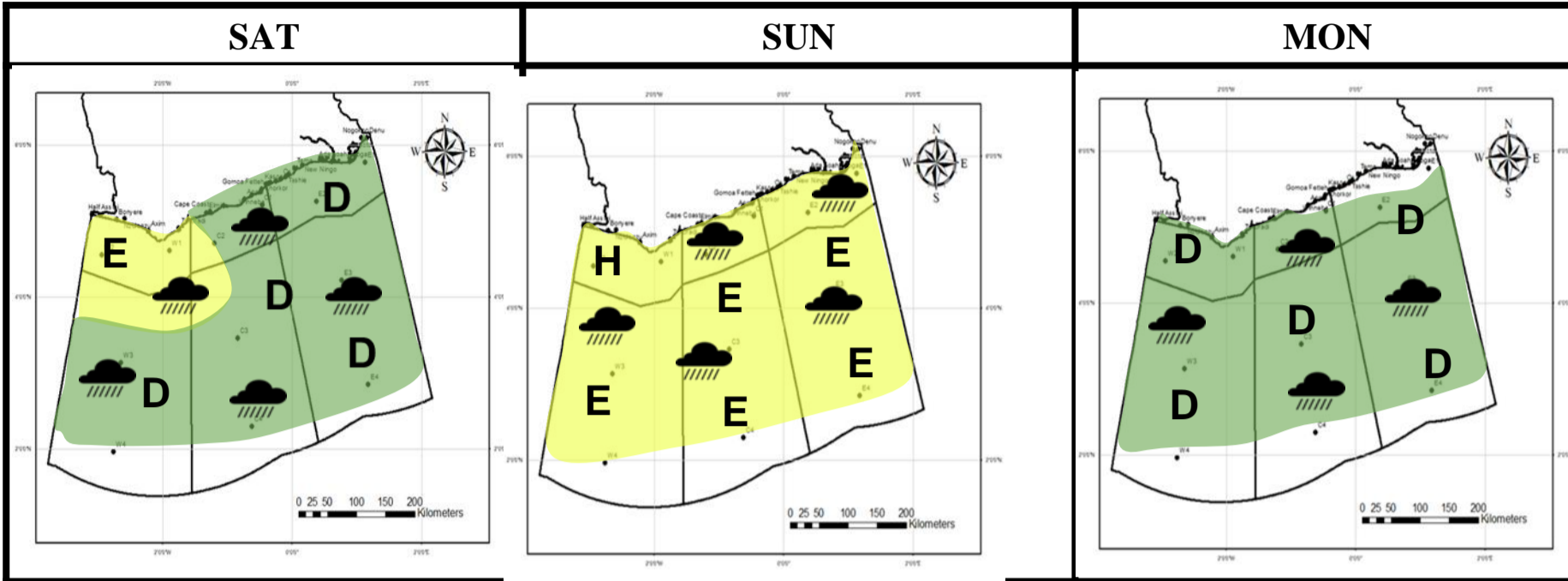

WEATHER SUMMARY

Expert general cloudiness over the marine space throughout the weekend. The clouds are forecast to produce scattered to widespread intermittent thunderstorms with rainfall across the entire area in varying intensities over the period. Also, gusty winds are likely to increase wave height, leading to slight to moderate occasional white horses, reducing visibility during the storm period.
