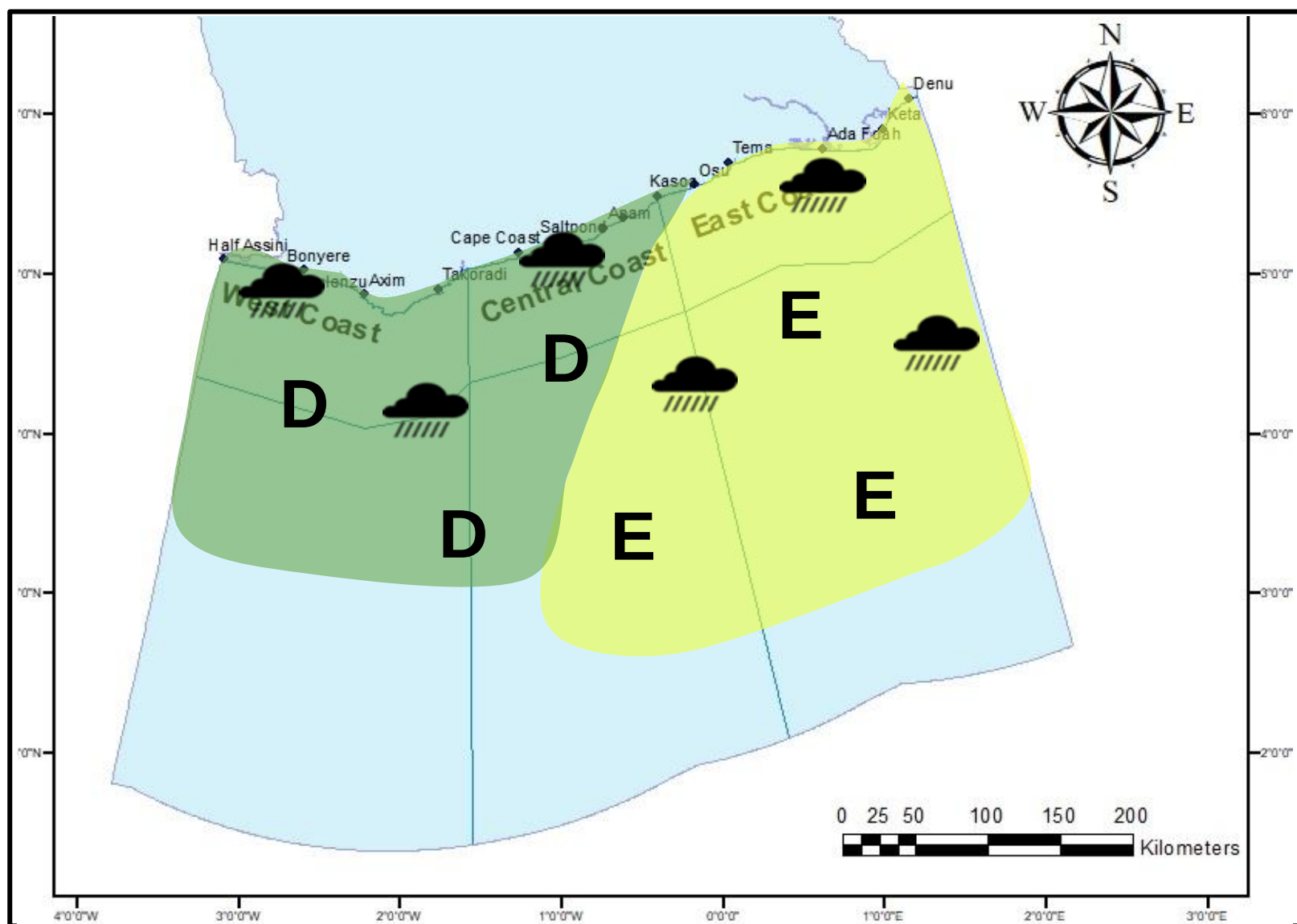

WEATHER SUMMARY: Mostly cloudy conditions will prevail over the maritime areas of our country in the afternoon through to the end of the forecast period. There is a 40-60% probability of isolated to scattered cases of thundery activities and rain with different intensities over onshore and offshore areas between the hours of the afternoon and evening.

NB: Rough Sea state is expected for the first 12 hours and will gradually change to dangerous for the next 24 hours.
