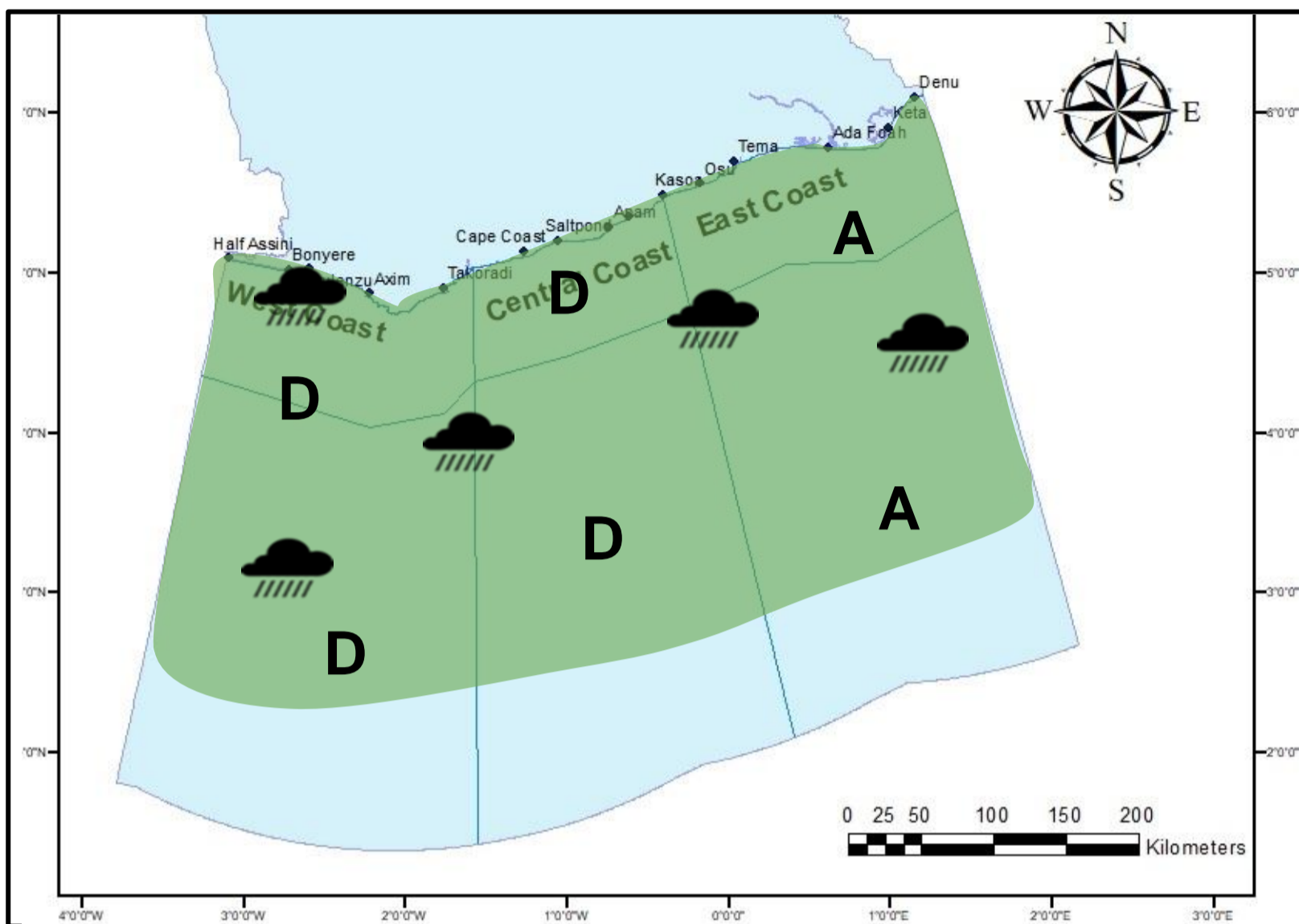

WEATHER SUMMARY: From the start of the forecast, mostly cloudy conditions are expected to dominate the marine area through the afternoon. Isolated thunderstorms and rain are anticipated over the west and central coasts and areas offshore from the morning and into the afternoon.
