WEATHER: The weather over the maritime area is expected to remain mostly cloudy along the coastlines and partly cloudy over the offshore areas. There is a 60% chance of thunder activities with rainfall of varying intensities along the coast, gradually spreading from the east to the west from midnight through the morning.

NB: Mariners are advised to be cautious of gusty winds over the western offshore areas from midnight to early morning, which may generate slight sea horses and reduce visibility.
