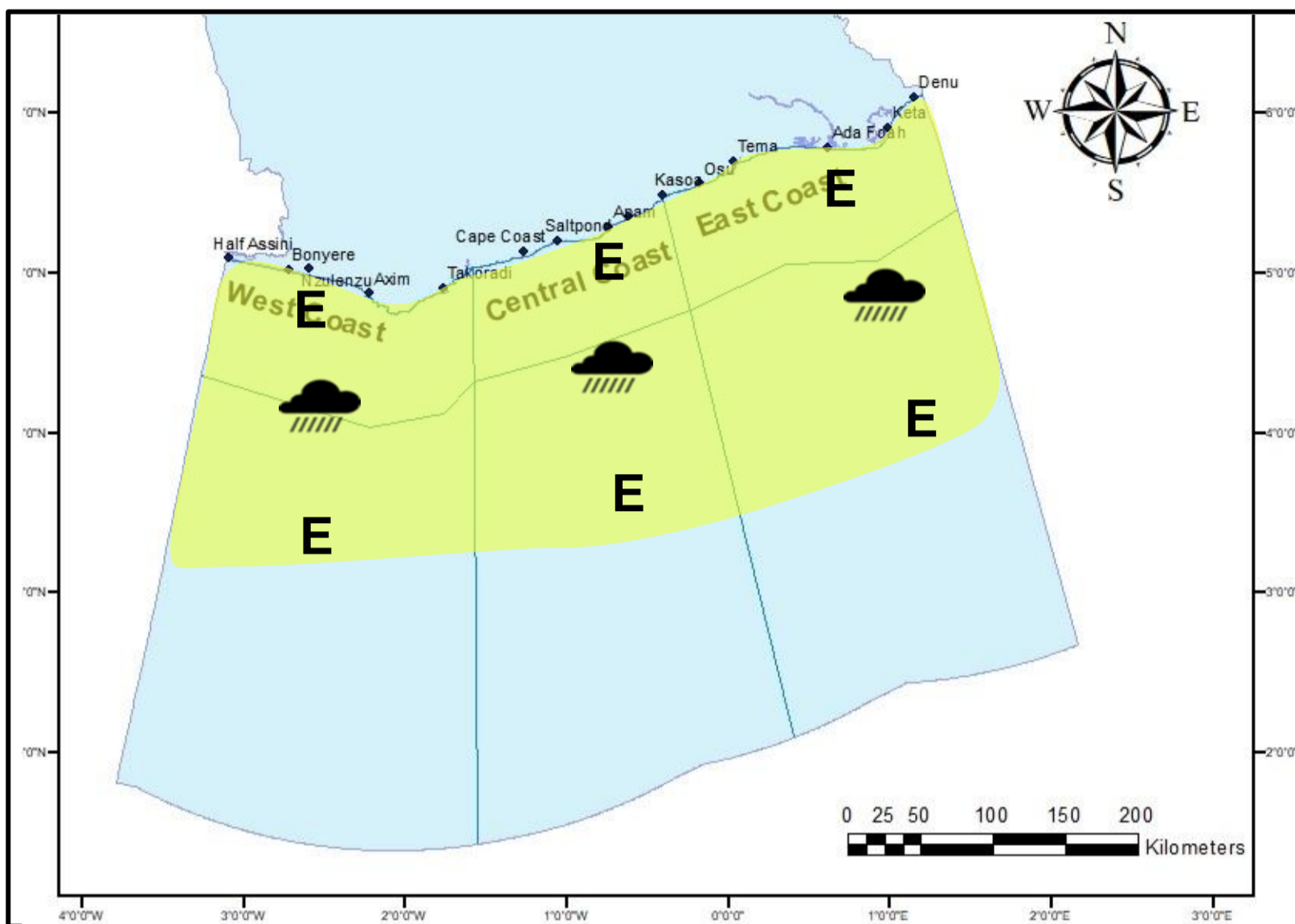

WEATHER SUMMARY: Mostly cloudy conditions are expected across the country's maritime area from the start of the forecast period through the afternoon. There is a 40–60% chance of thunderstorms and rain over the eastern and central coasts in the morning, spreading gradually westward from late morning into the afternoon. Gusty winds are likely to precede the rainfall.
