WEATHER: Expect mostly cloudy weather across the marine space from this afternoon through the evening. There is more than 60% probability of scattered to widespread thunderstorms with rainfall of varying intensities, moving westward from the east, and reaching the western areas by evening. **Meanwhile, sea conditions are forecast to remain very rough throughout the period.**
