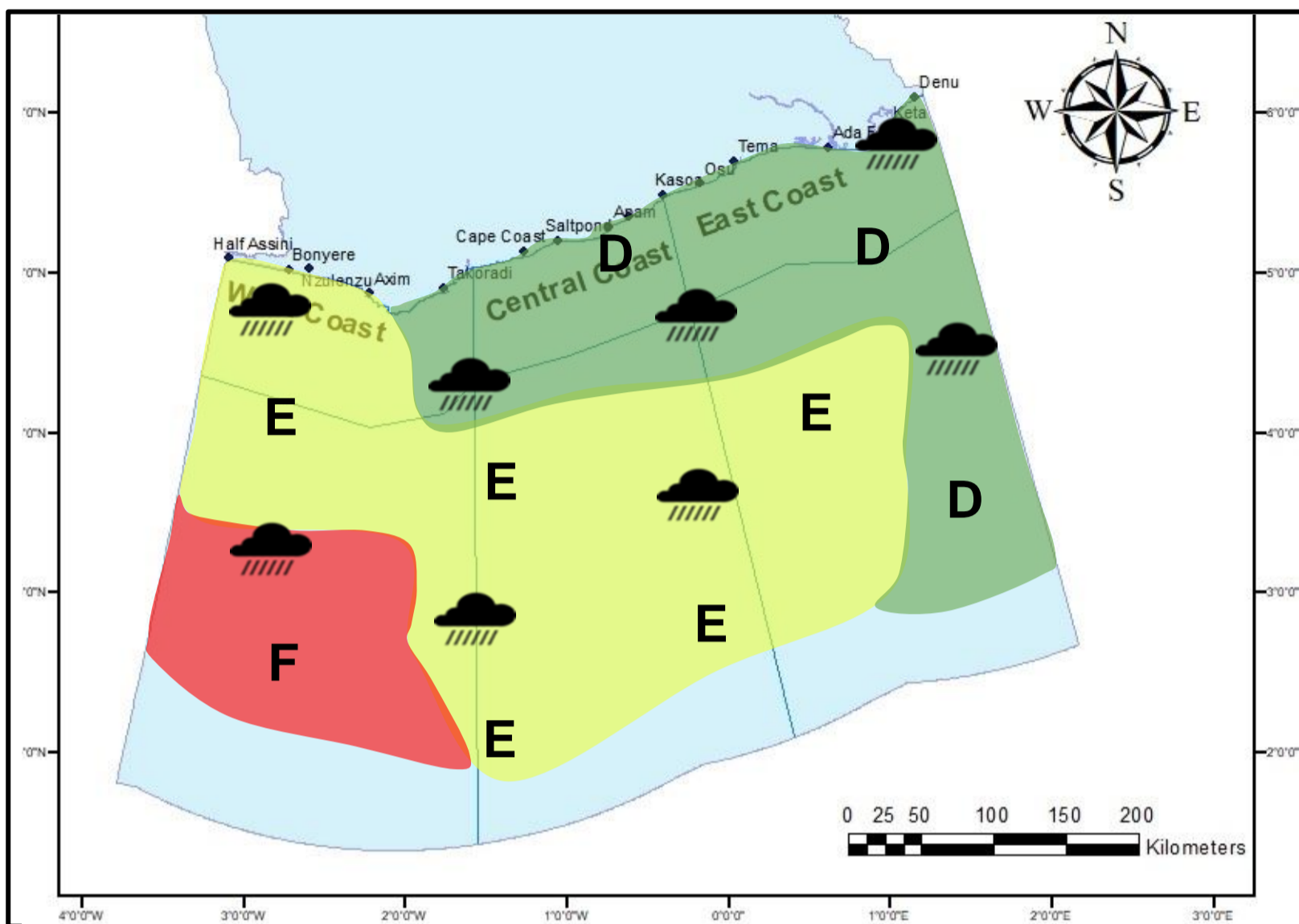

WEATHER SUMMARY: Cloudy conditions are expected to persist over the marine area throughout the forecast period, gradually developing into scattered to widespread moderate to heavy thunderstorms with rain, particularly along the west coast, from around midnight through the afternoon. These storm systems are likely to be preceded by gusty winds. **In addition, sea conditions are forecast to become dangerous during the morning hours.**
