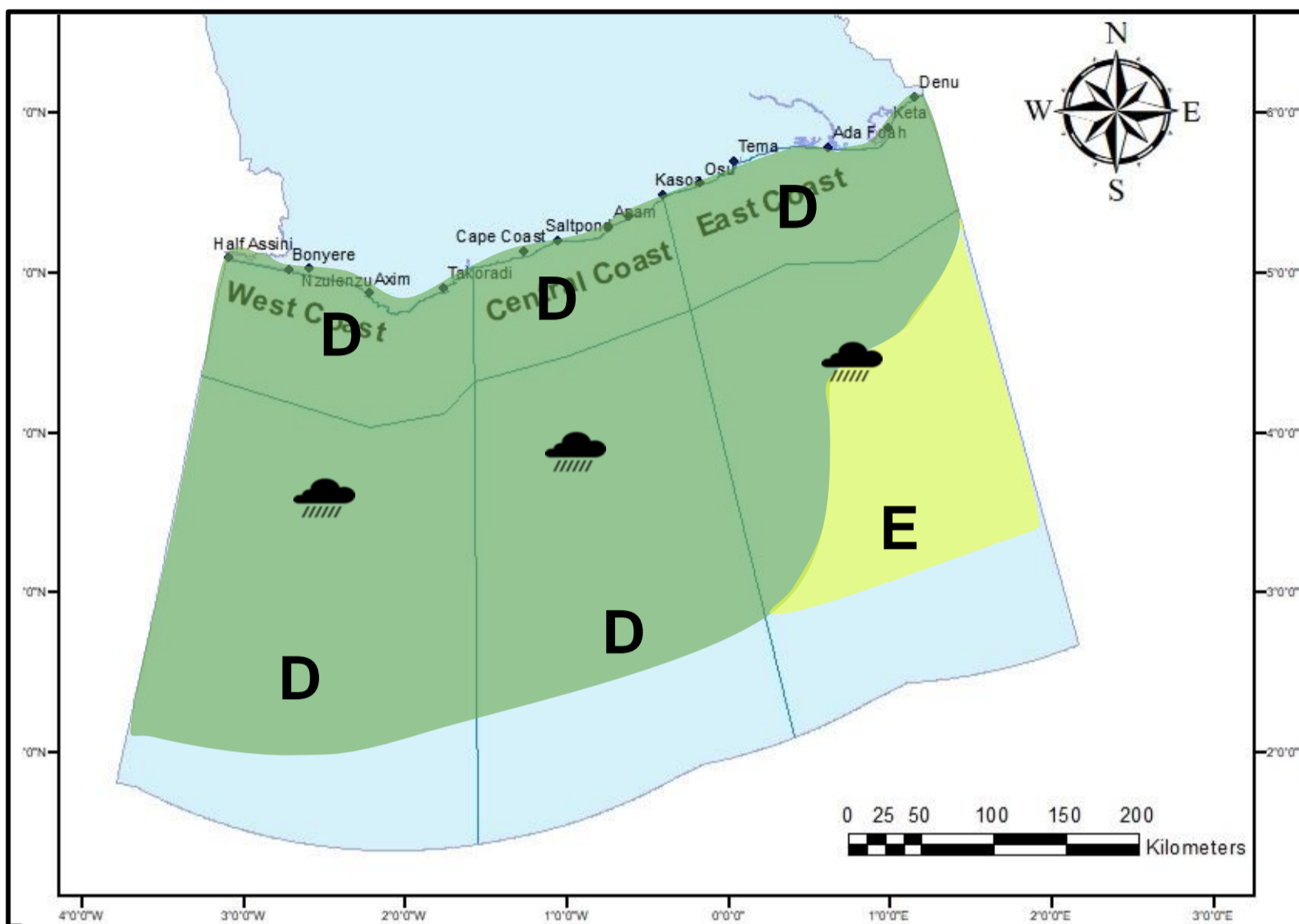

WEATHER SUMMARY: Expect variably cloudy weather conditions over the nation's marine space throughout the forecast period. In the morning, cases of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by rainfall of varying intensities, with a 60% probability of occurrence, are anticipated to affect both coastal and offshore areas.

NB: The state of the sea is expected to be rough during the storm.
