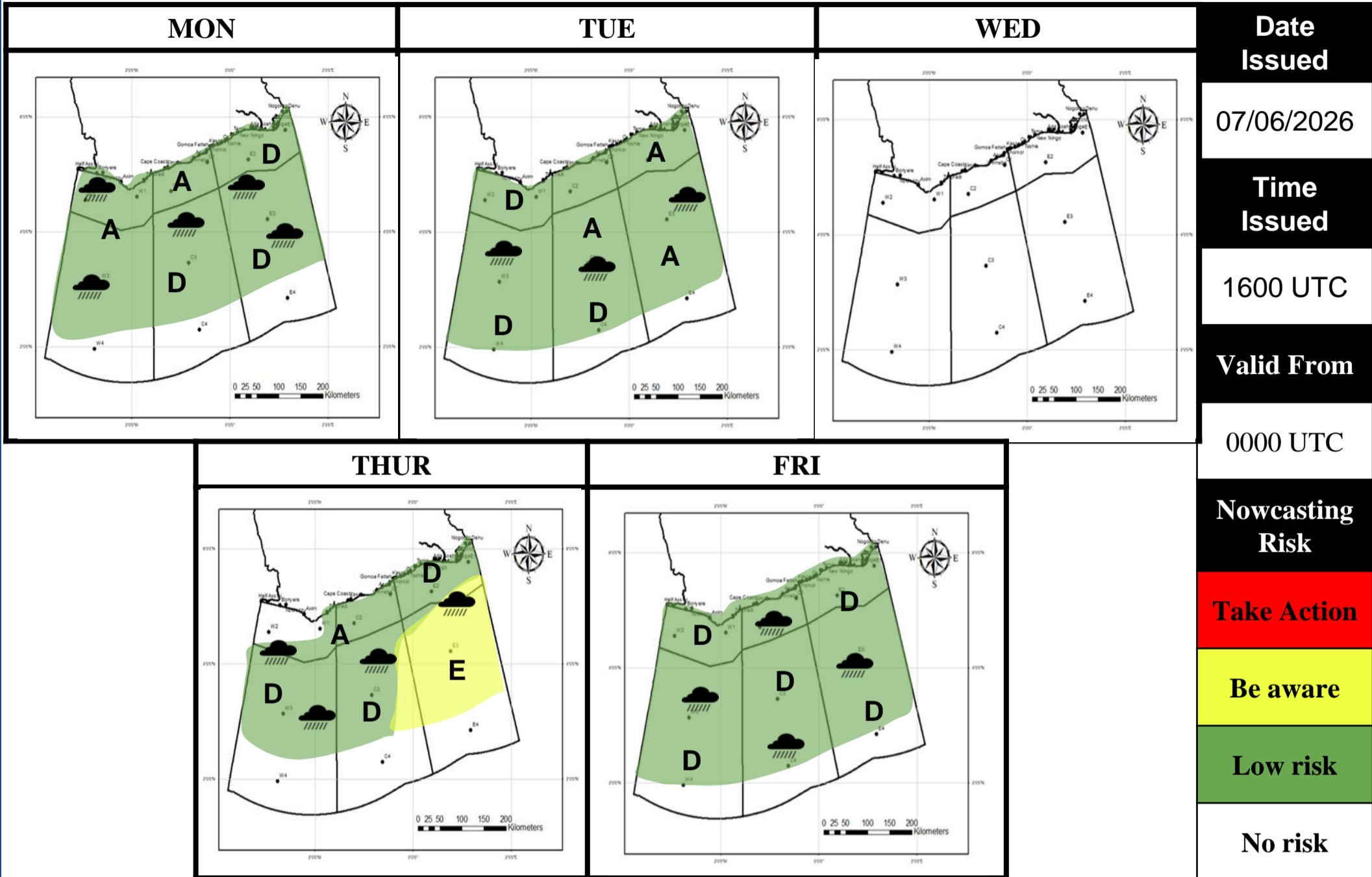

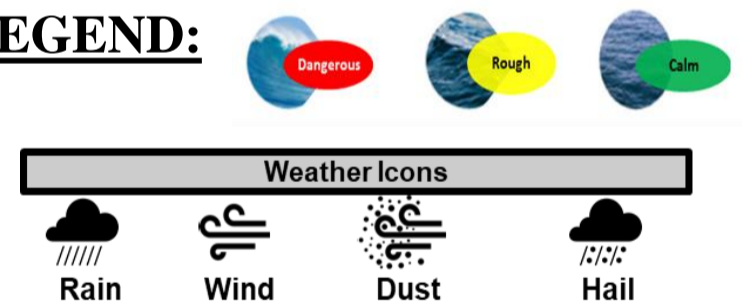

WEATHER SUMMARY

Expect variable cloud cover over the marine space throughout the week, with sunny afternoons, particularly along the coastlines. Meanwhile, there will be instances of intermittent rainfall with possible thunder over isolated areas, both onshore and offshore. The state of the sea is expected to be rough, producing light to moderate sea horses and reducing visibility for most of the forecast duration.
