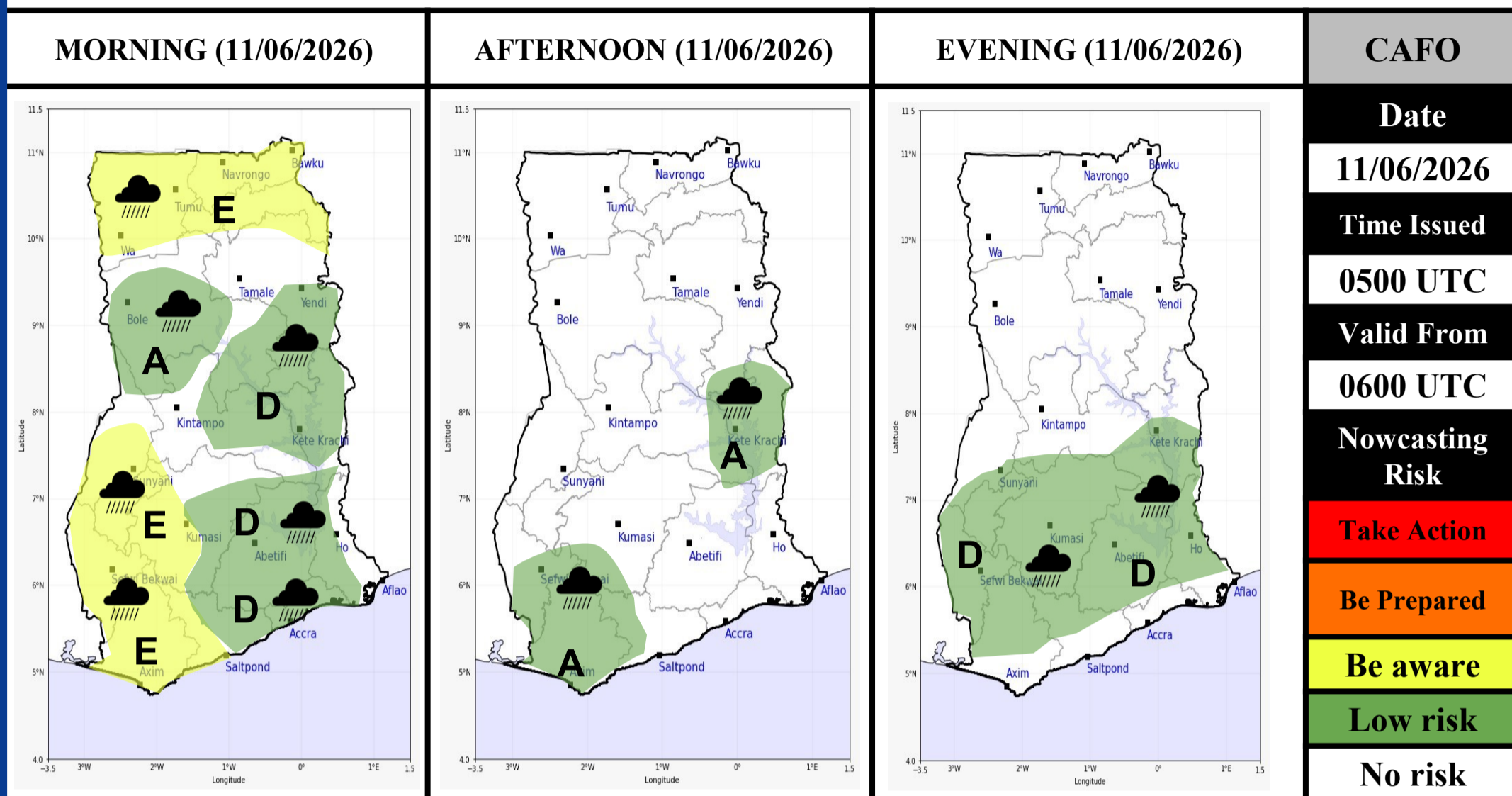




## 24-HOUR IMPACT-BASED FORECAST FOR GHANA

| Sector     | Minimum Temperature (°C) | Maximum Temperature (°C) |
|------------|--------------------------|--------------------------|
| Coast      | 22                       | 32                       |
| Forest     | 22                       | 33                       |
| Transition | 22                       | 34                       |
| Northern   | 23                       | 34                       |

**SUMMARY:** This morning, thunderstorms or rain of different intensity will persist in many parts of the country. Mist or fog may also occur in a few places across southern Ghana, which could reduce visibility. Later in the day, mixture of sun and clouds will be observed. However, from late afternoon into the night, thunderstorms or rain are likely to affect some areas within the forest and transitions zones.
