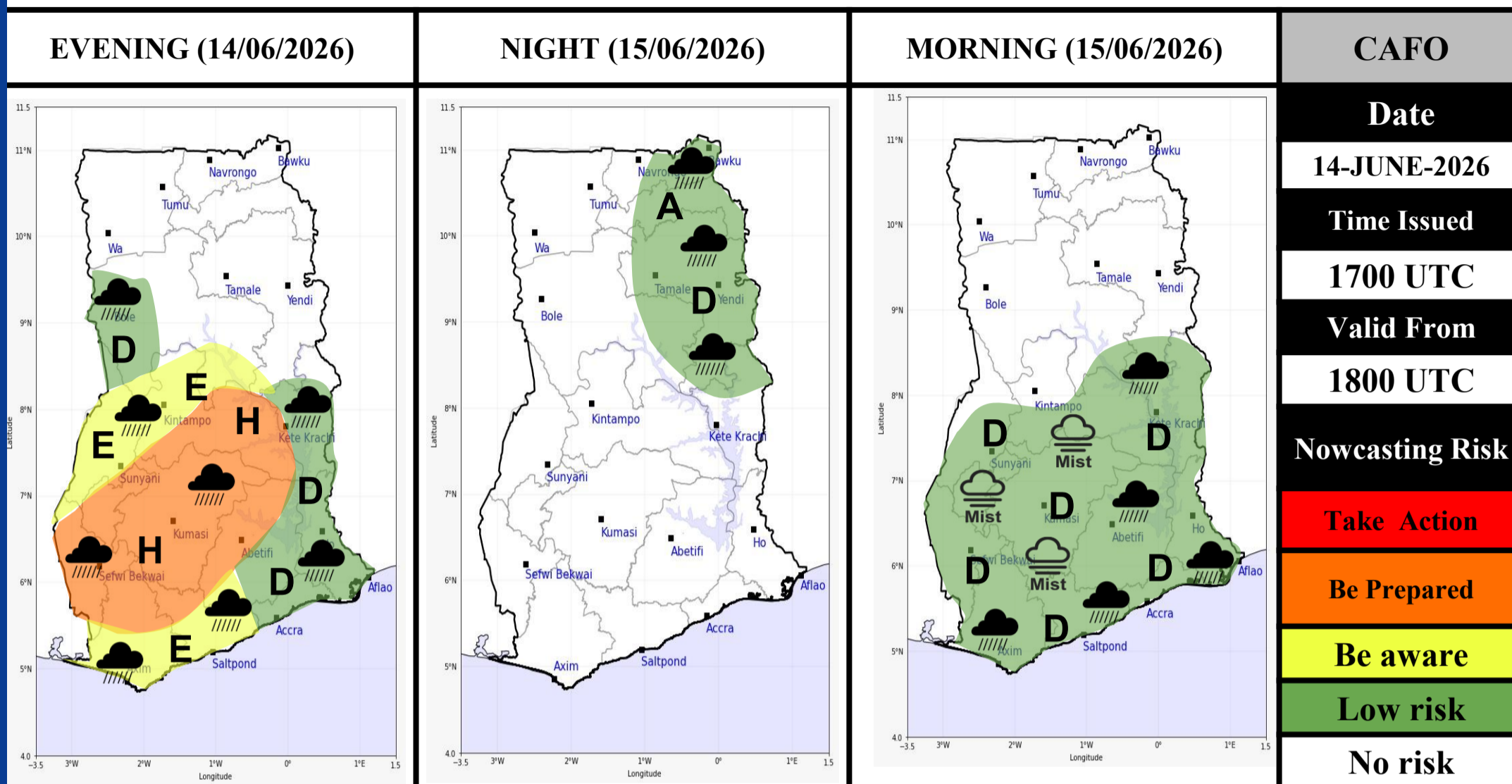




## 24-HOUR IMPACT-BASED FORECAST FOR GHANA

**SUMMARY:** This evening, mostly cloudy conditions will prevail over southern Ghana, with thunderstorms or rain of varying intensities affecting many places. Meanwhile, partly cloudy weather will dominate northern Ghana, with thunderstorms or rain anticipated later in the night. Early Monday morning, mist and fog patches are expected to form over parts of the forest and mountainous areas, with a likelihood of rain over areas along the coast and parts of the middle and transition sectors.
