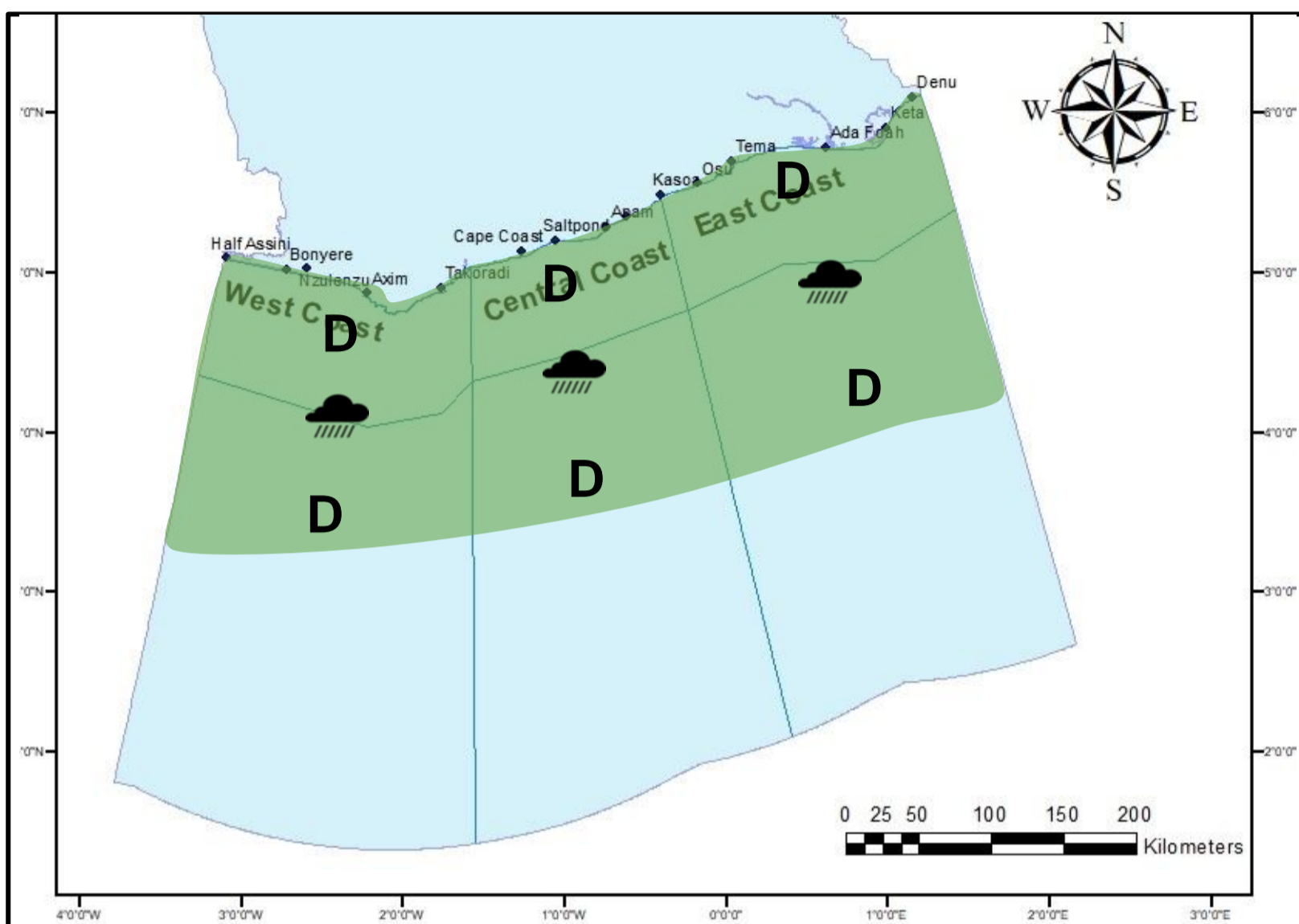

WEATHER SUMMARY: Generally, cloudy weather conditions are expected to dominate the nation's maritime space throughout the forecast period. However, there is a 40–60% chance of isolated to scattered light to moderate rain and thunderstorms, accompanied by gusty winds, affecting both coastal and offshore areas from this afternoon through the evening.

NB: Sailors are advised to exercise caution as the state of the sea is expected to be very rough over some offshore areas during the forecast validity period.
