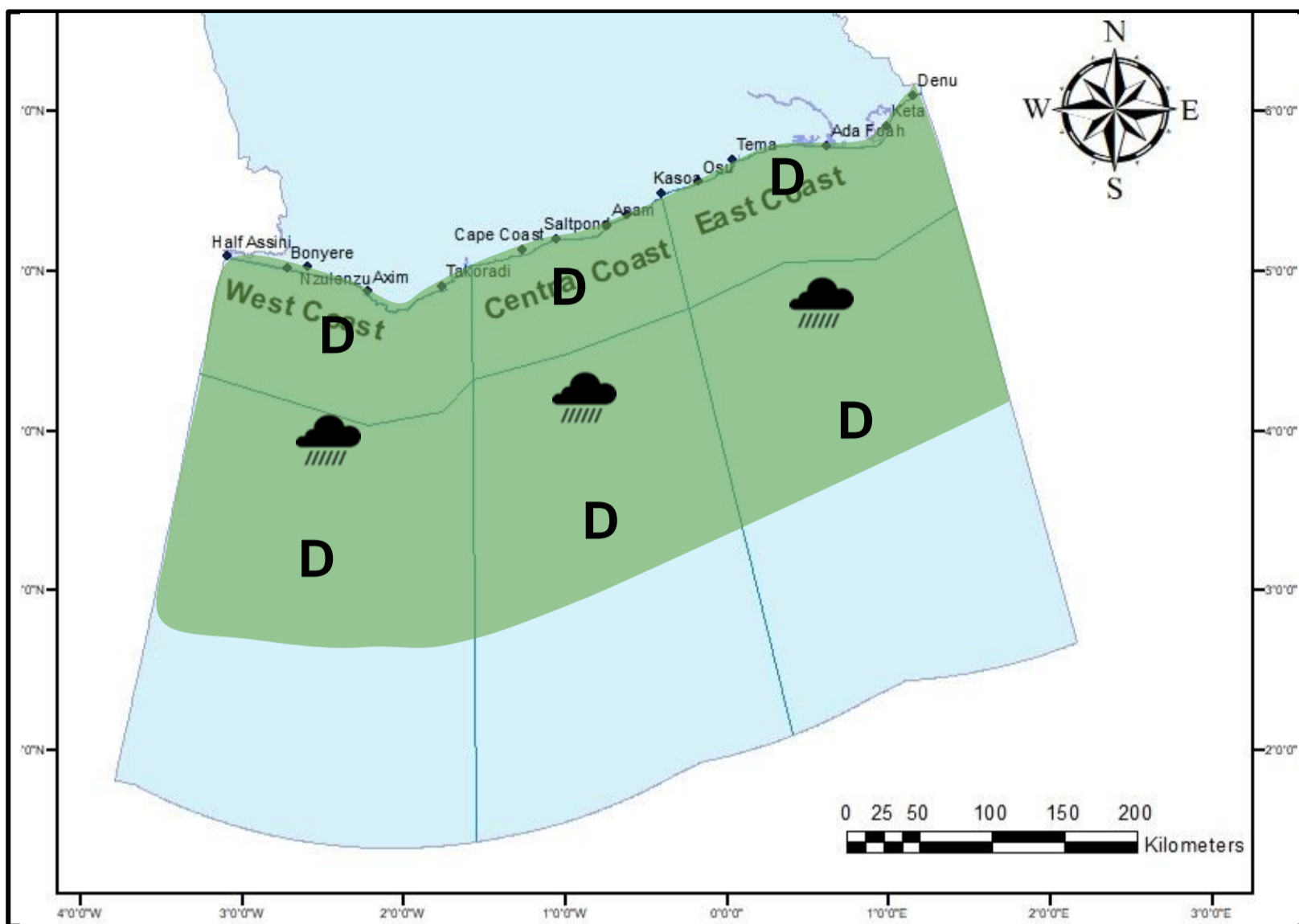

WEATHER SUMMARY: The prevailing cloudy weather conditions over the country's maritime space are anticipated to persist throughout the forecast period. However, isolated light-to-moderate intermittent rain, accompanied by thunderstorms and strong winds, with a 40–60% likelihood, is expected to affect both onshore and offshore areas between midnight and the morning hours.

NB: Sailors are advised to exercise caution as the state of the sea is expected to remain very rough over some offshore areas during the forecast validity period.
