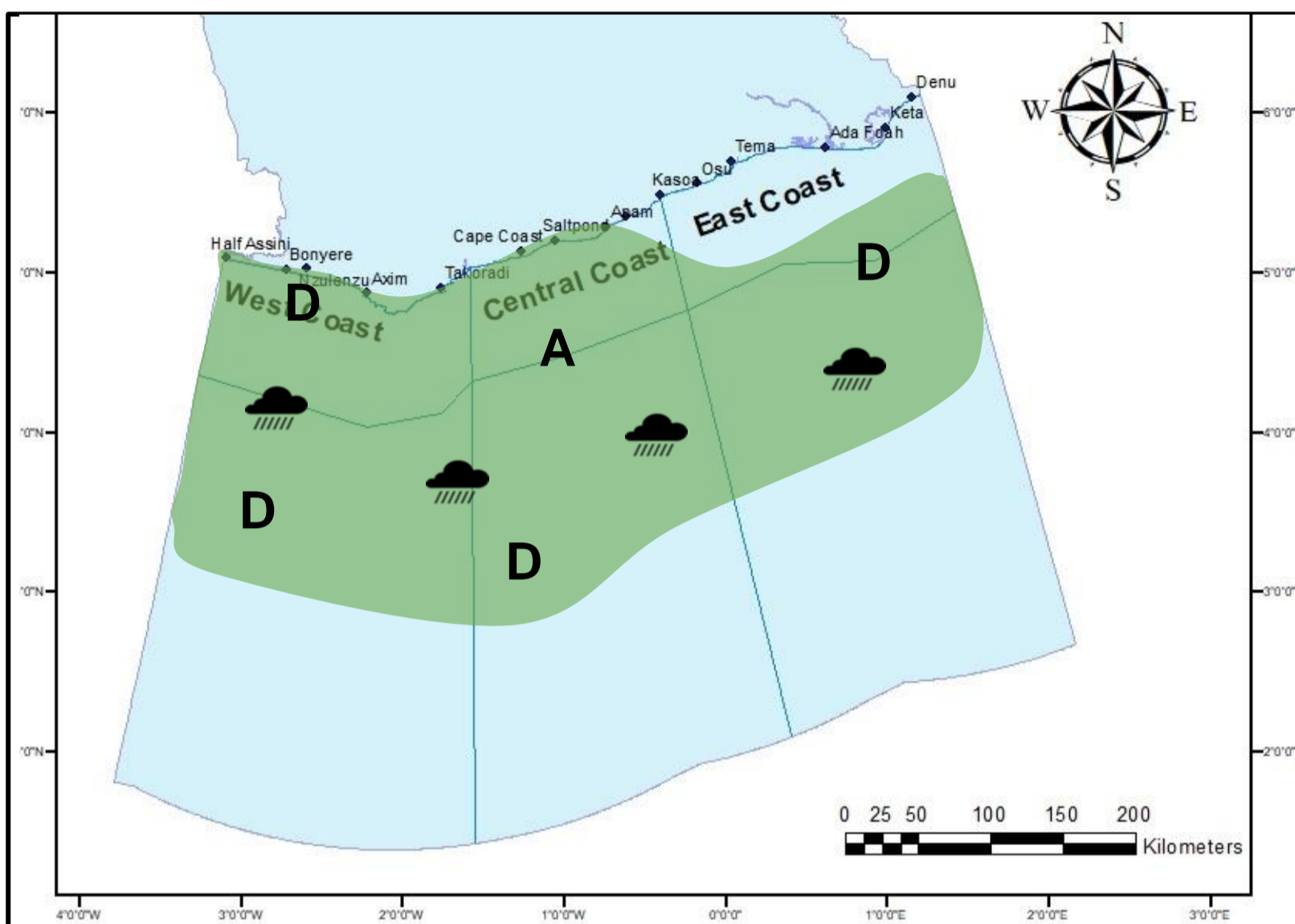

WEATHER SUMMARY: Broken clouds are expected to dominate the country's maritime areas throughout the forecast period, with sunny afternoons along the coastlines. But there is a 40% chance of scattered rain, with thunderstorms developing in the afternoon and dominating the offshore areas.

NB: Sailors are advised to exercise caution as the state of the sea is expected to be very rough with gusty winds, especially over the offshore region during the forecast validity period.
