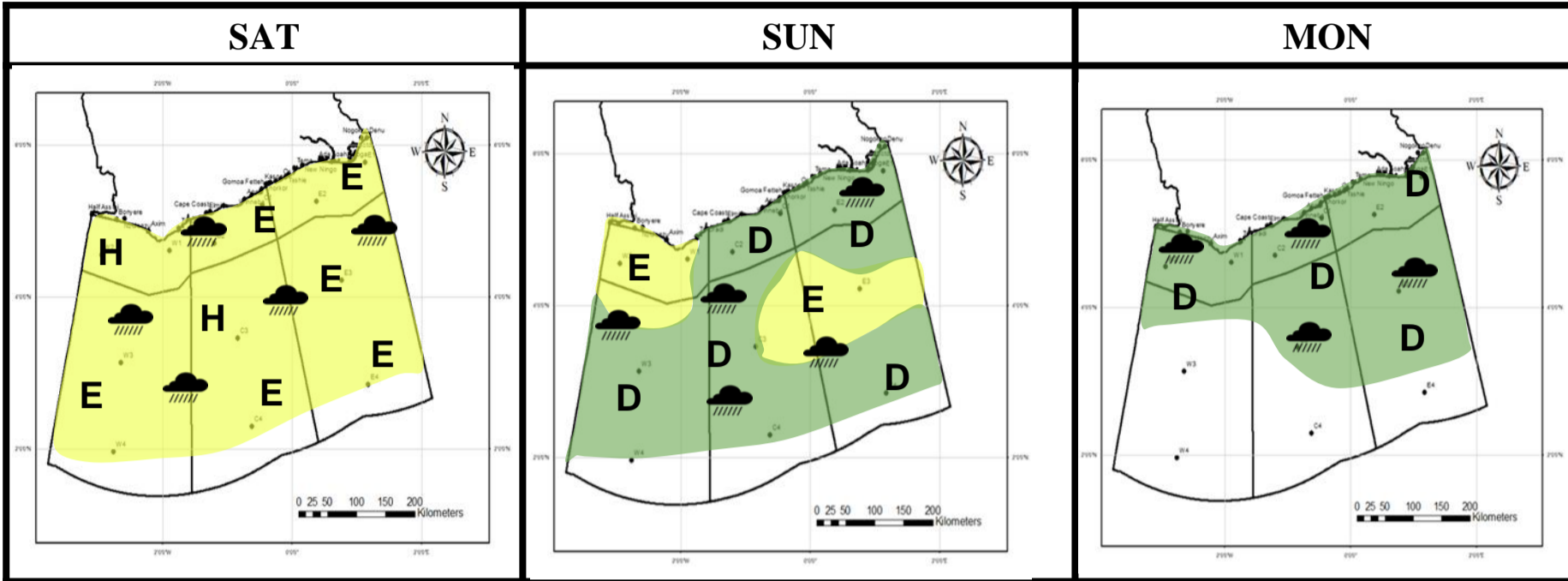

WEATHER SUMMARY

Over the weekend, the nation's marine area is expected to be mostly cloudy, with brief periods of afternoon sunshine along coastline areas. Rainfall, ranging from scattered to widespread and varying in intensity, may occur across both onshore and offshore seas, with the possibility of thunderstorms, accompanied by gusty winds. Sea conditions are forecast to remain rough throughout the weekend, while strong north-east currents are likely along the central and eastern coastlines.
