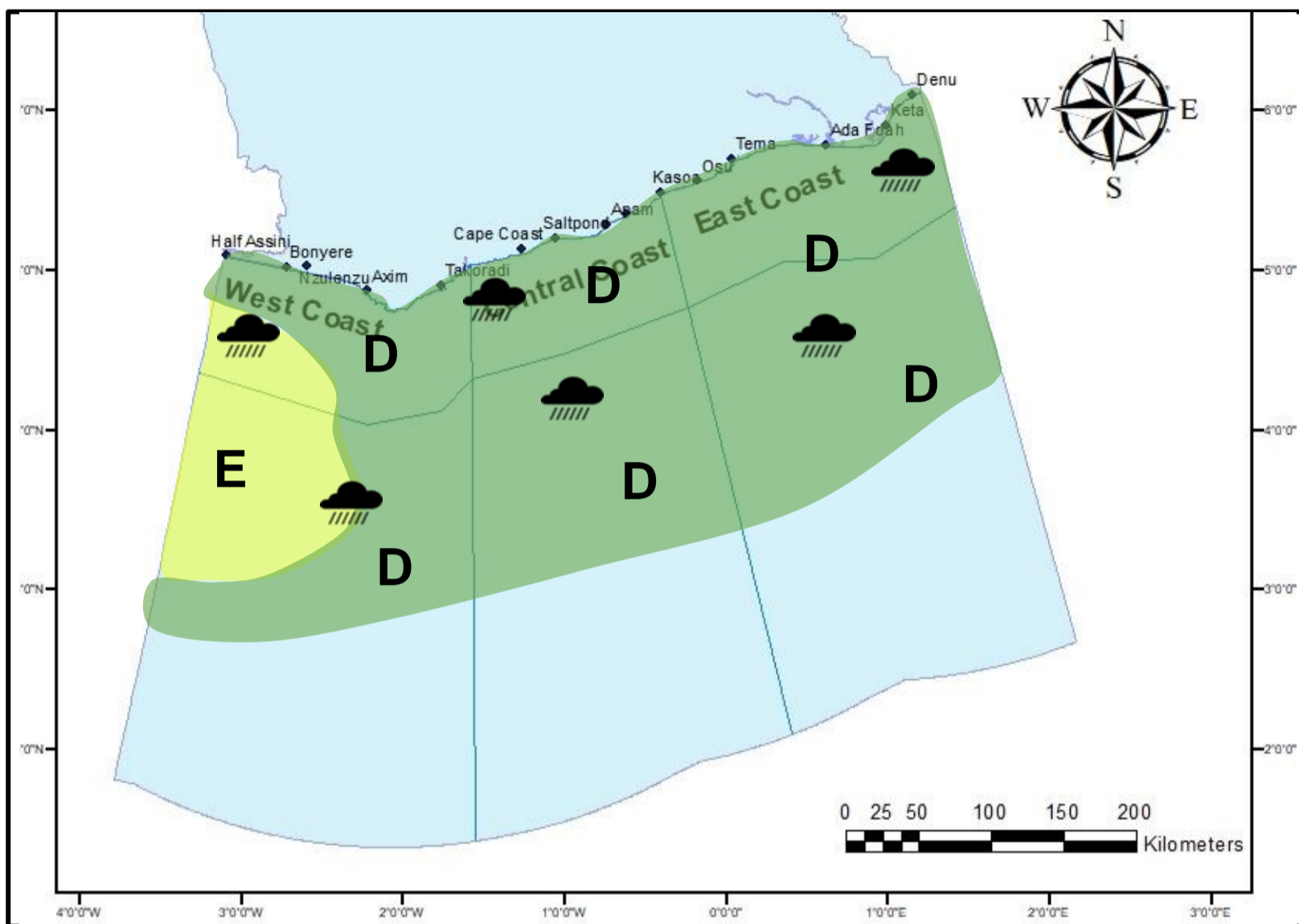

WEATHER SUMMARY: Broken clouds are expected to dominate the country's maritime areas throughout the forecast period, with sunny afternoons along the coastlines. Meanwhile, clouds are expected with a 40% chance of developing into scattered rain with thunder of varying intensity from the afternoon into the night.

NB: Strong winds will persist offshore from this afternoon into the evening. In line with seasonal conditions, rough seas are anticipated throughout the forecast period.
