SUMMARY: Mostly cloudy conditions with breaks of sunshine will dominate most parts of the country this afternoon. A rainstorm observed within the **Gulf of Guinea** is anticipated to move westward and trigger thunderstorms or rain along the coast and nearby inland areas. **However, a separate rainstorm sighted over the north of Benin is expected to enter the country and produce thunderstorms or rain over the northern sector from afternoon into evening hours.** These rain bearing systems are expected to induce cloudiness as well as thunderstorms over the middle and transition sectors.
