WEATHER: Mostly cloudy weather conditions are expected to prevail across the country's marine space, reducing visibility significantly for much of the forecast period. However, there is a 40 - 60% chance of scattered light to moderate rainfall mainly during the morning hours and into the afternoon, affecting both coastal and offshore regions, particularly in the central and east coast areas.

NB: Strong winds will persist offshore from morning into the afternoon. In line with seasonal conditions, rough seas are anticipated throughout the entire forecast period.
