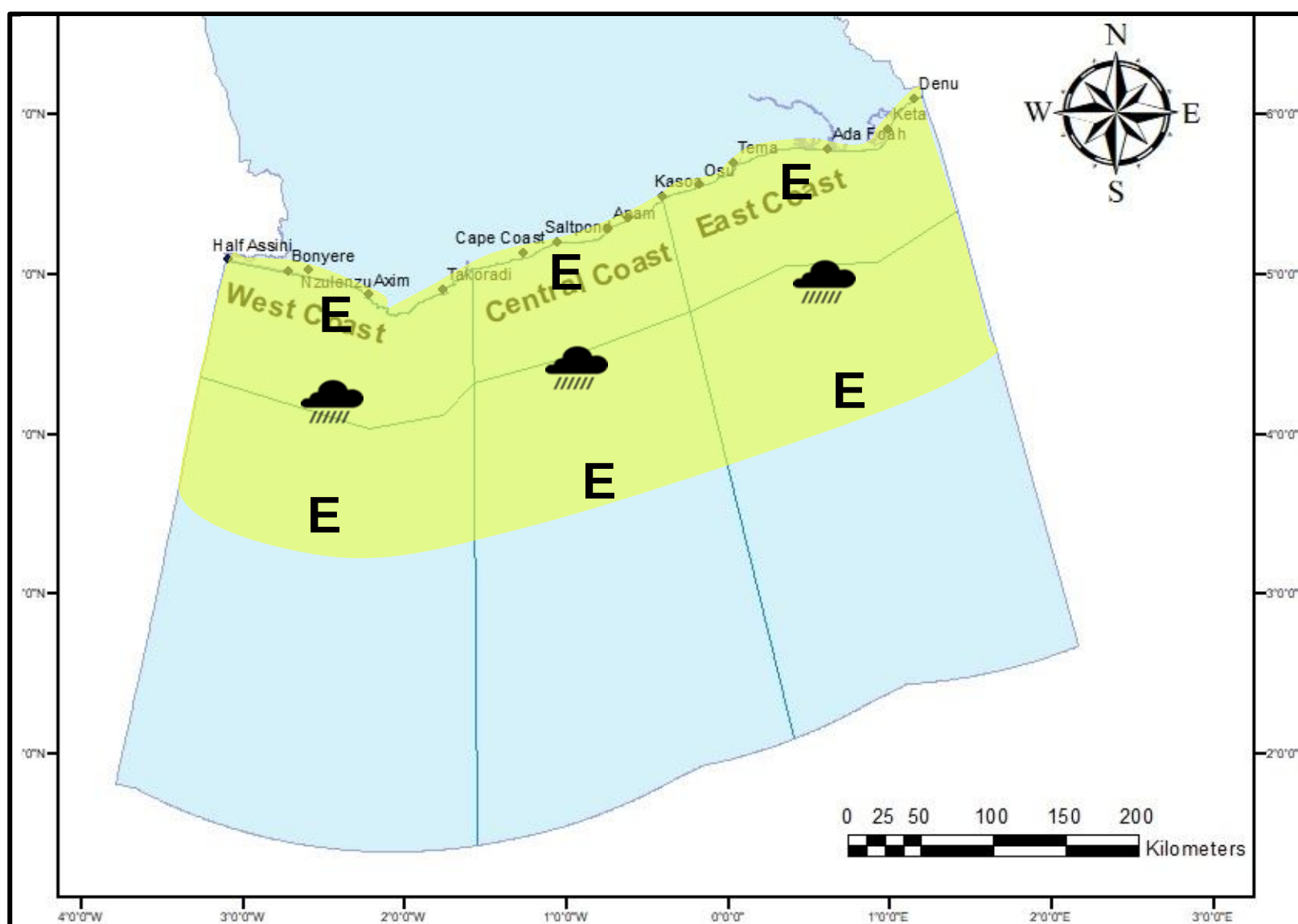

WEATHER SUMMARY: The prevailing cloudy weather conditions across the maritime space are expected to persist throughout the forecast duration. There is, however, a 40-60% likelihood of isolated to scattered thunderstorms and rainfall of varying intensity over onshore and some offshore areas from the afternoon through the night.

NB: Sailors are advised to exercise caution, as the sea state is expected to be very rough to dangerous, with strong winds over some coastal areas during the forecast validity period.
