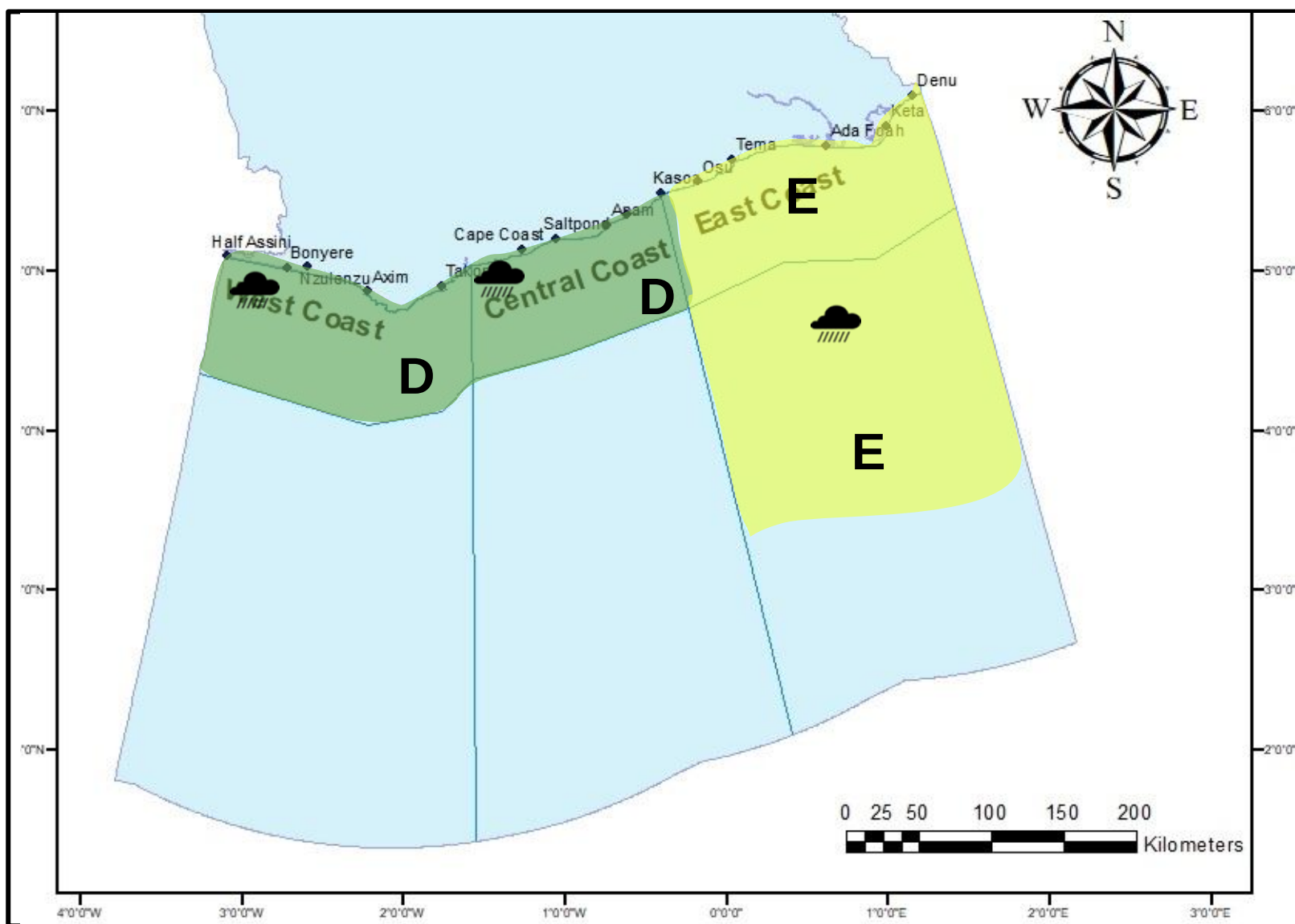

WEATHER SUMMARY: Predominantly cloudy weather conditions are expected to prevail across the nation's maritime space throughout the forecast period. However, there is a 40–60% chance of isolated to scattered rainfall of varying intensity, accompanied by strong winds from midnight through the morning and into the afternoon. These conditions are expected to affect onshore and some offshore areas, particularly east offshore.

NB: Sailors are advised to exercise caution, as the sea state is expected to be very rough over some coastal areas during the forecast period.
