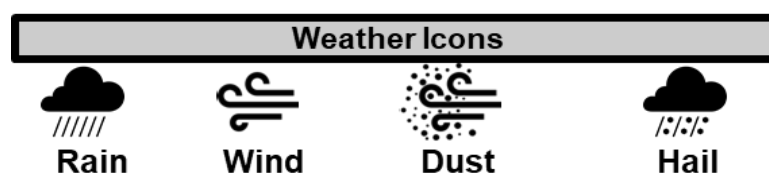
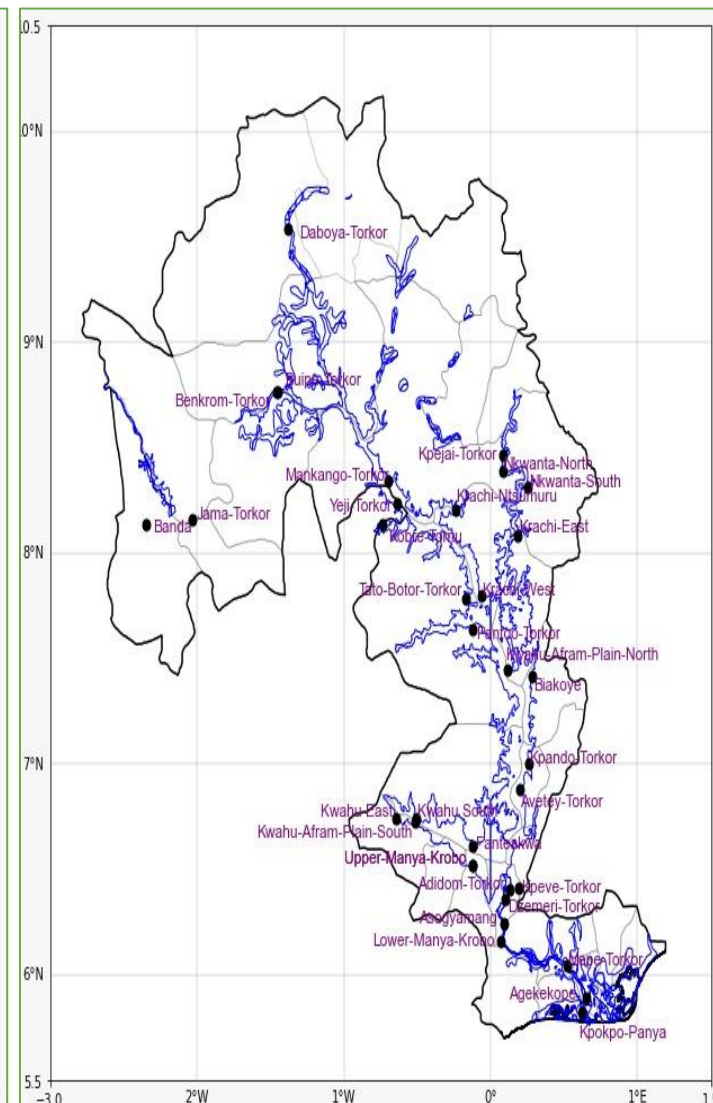
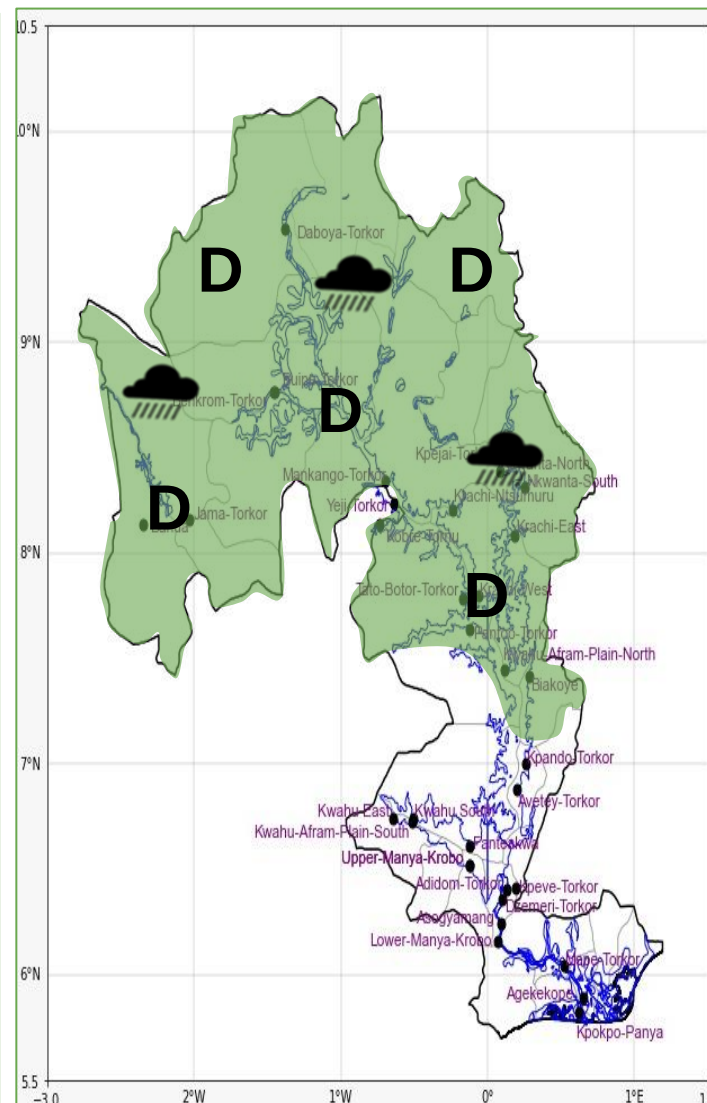
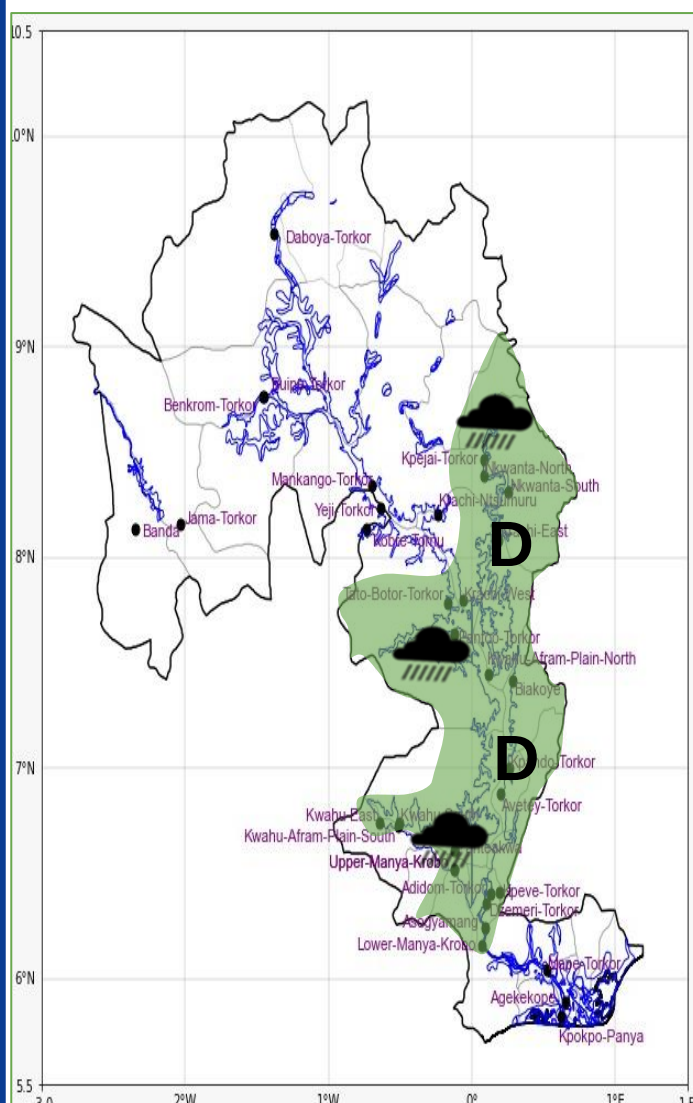
WEATHER SUMMARY
