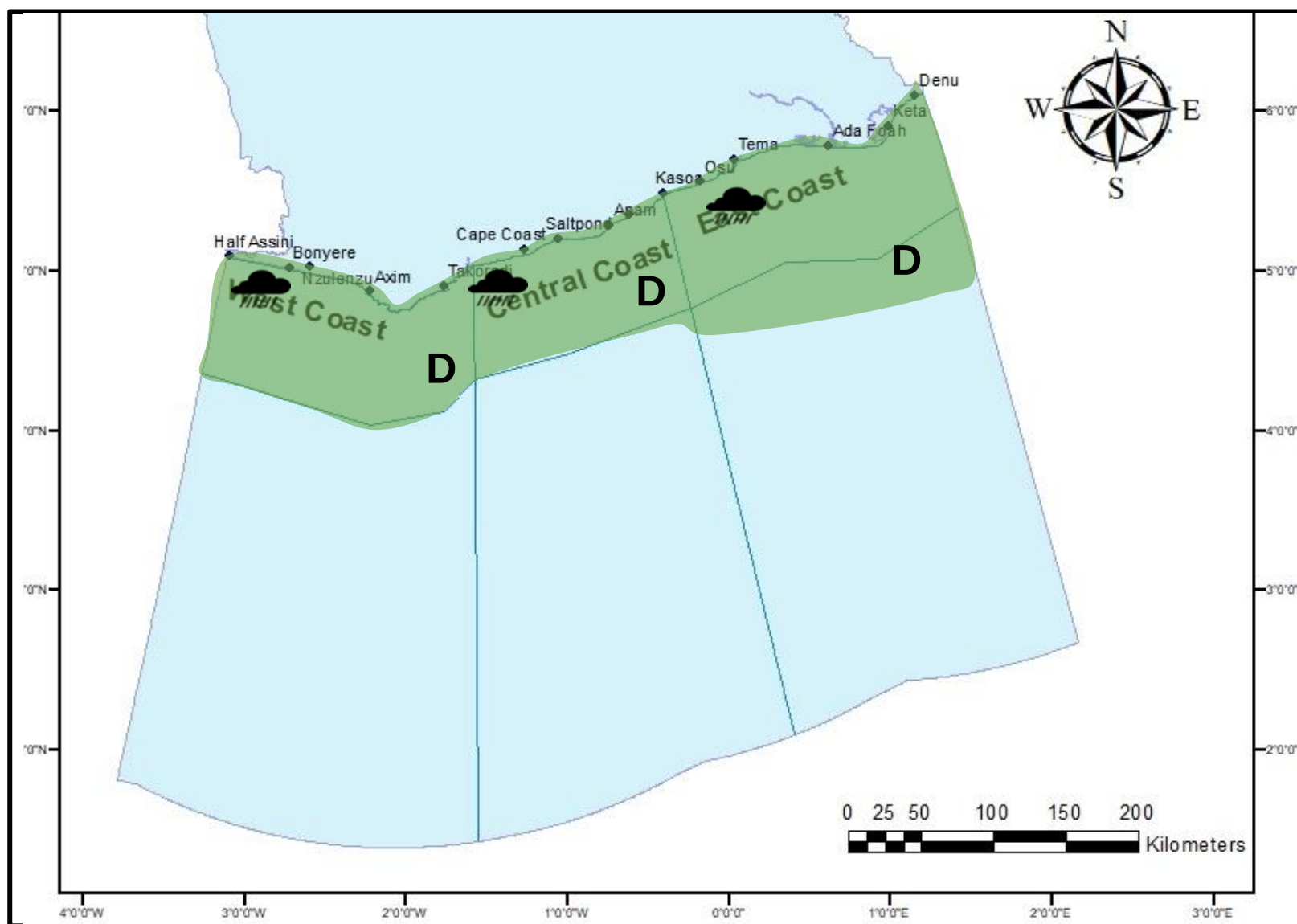

WEATHER SUMMARY: The prevailing cloudy weather conditions across the nation's maritime space are expected to persist throughout the forecast period. Isolated to scattered rainfall of varying intensity, accompanied by thunderstorms, is anticipated with a 60% chance during midnight and the morning hours. These weather conditions are expected to affect both onshore and offshore areas.

NB: The state of the sea is expected to be dangerous during the morning hours.
