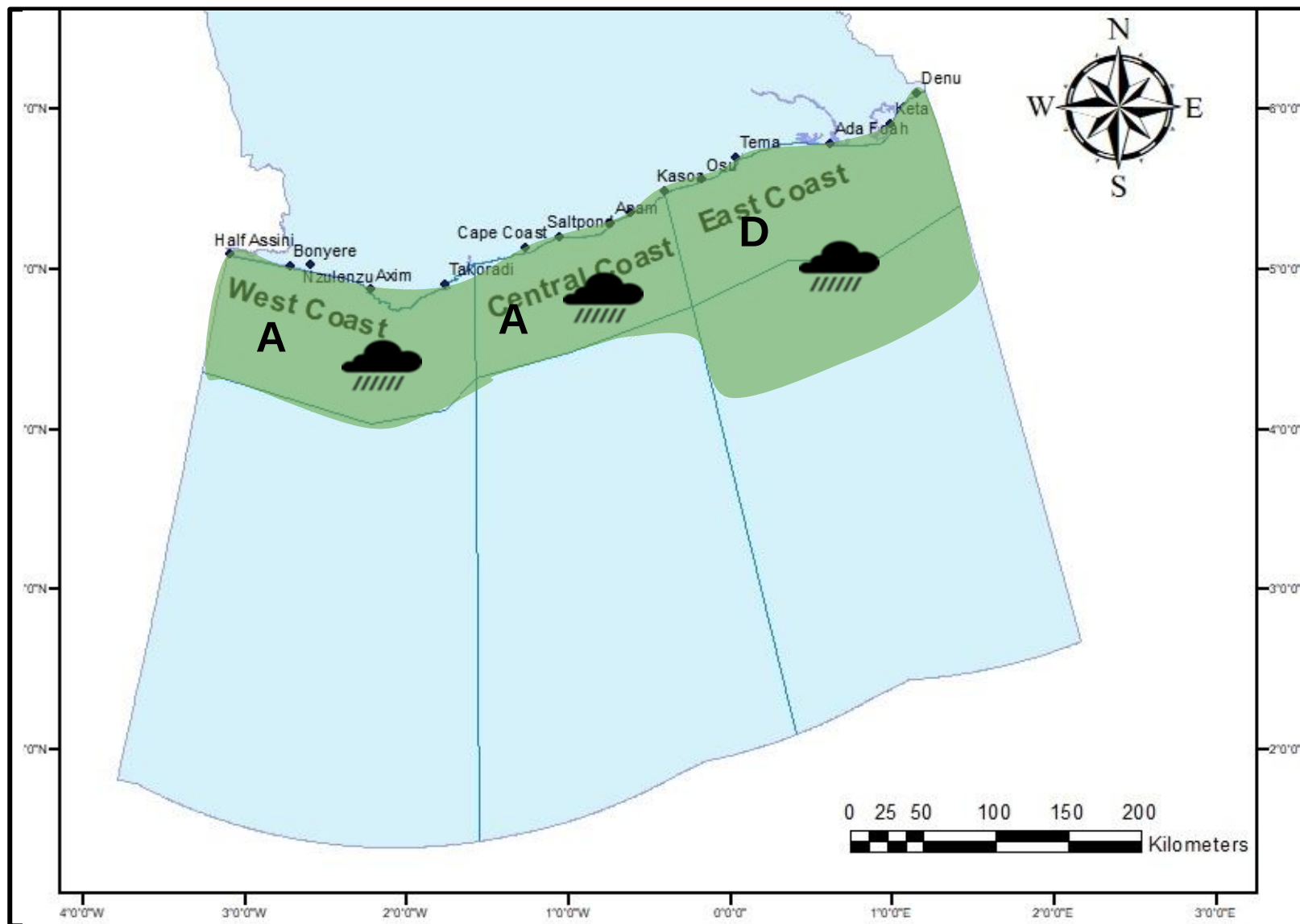

WEATHER SUMMARY: Cloudy weather conditions across the maritime space are expected to persist throughout the forecast validity period. There is, however, a 30-40% chance of isolated light to moderate rain over onshore and some offshore areas, particularly the east coast during the morning hours.
