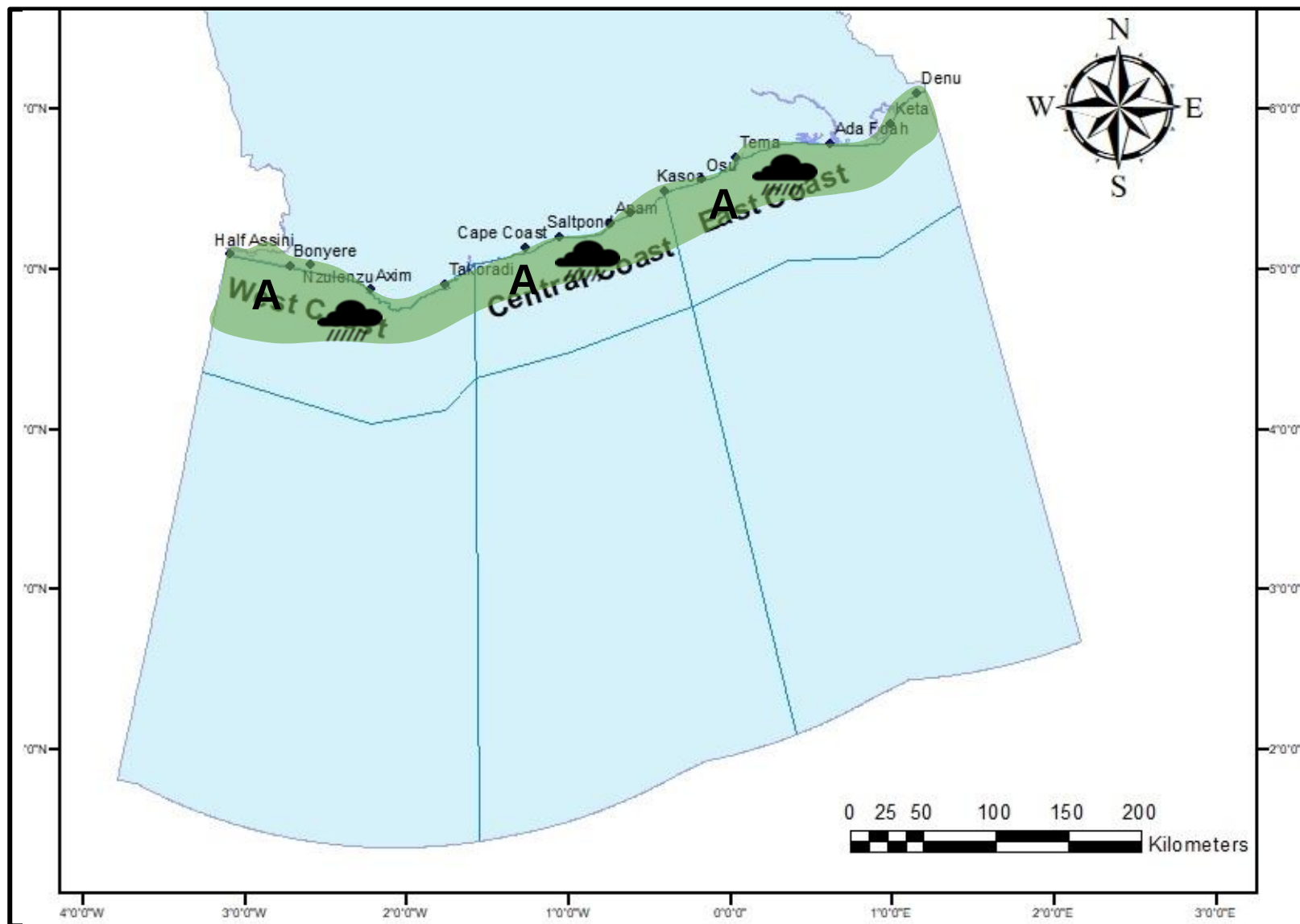

WEATHER SUMMARY: Variable cloudiness is expected over the country's maritime area during the morning hours, creating generally fair conditions with occasional cloud cover. However, there is a 30% chance of isolated rain. As the day progresses into the afternoon, sunny intervals are expected to develop along the coast.
