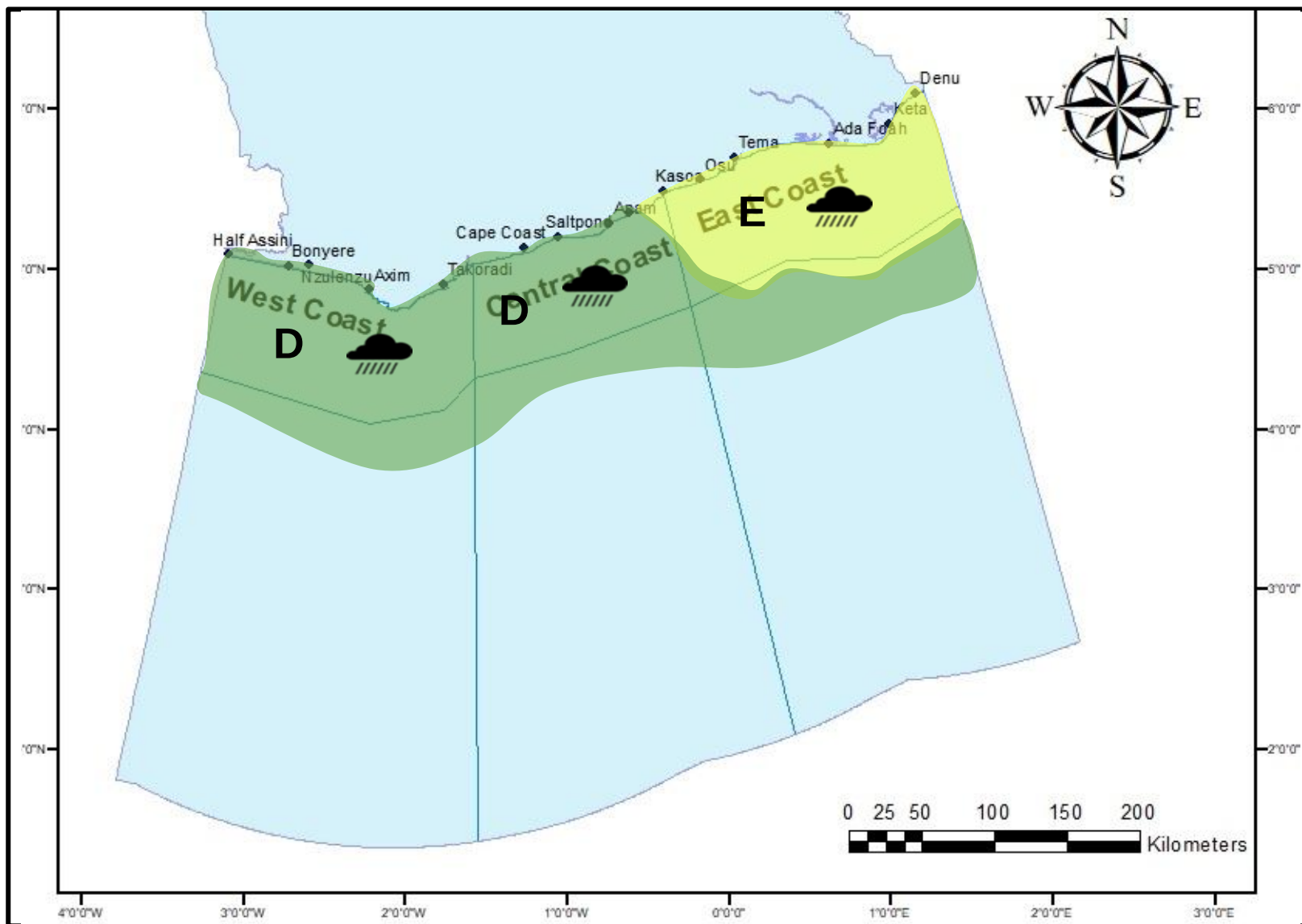

WEATHER SUMMARY: Mostly cloudy conditions are expected to persist across the country's maritime area, which will reduce visibility. However, these clouds are likely to produce intermittent rainfall, with a 40-60% chance, especially along the east coast. Additionally, gusty winds will accompany the rain throughout the forecast period.

NB: Rough sea state is expected during the forecast period; sailors are advised to exercise caution.
