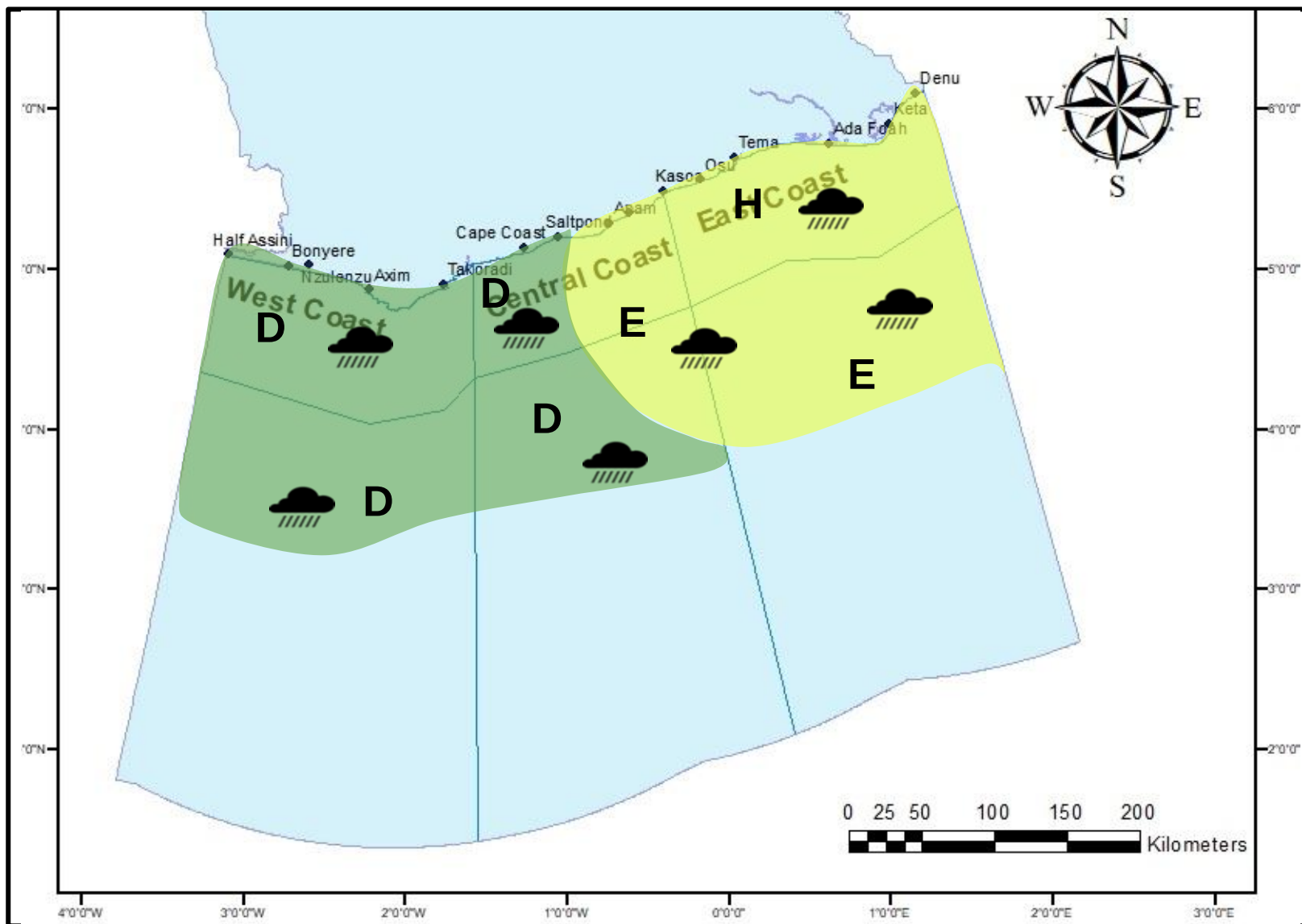

WEATHER SUMMARY: Predominantly cloudy weather conditions are expected to persist across the country's maritime area, resulting in reduced visibility. However, these clouds are likely to bring scattered rain and thunderstorms, with a 60% chance of occurrence, particularly along the east and central coast as well as their offshore areas. Additionally, gusty winds are expected to accompany the rain throughout the forecast period.

NB: Rough sea state is expected during the forecast period; sailors are advised to exercise caution.
