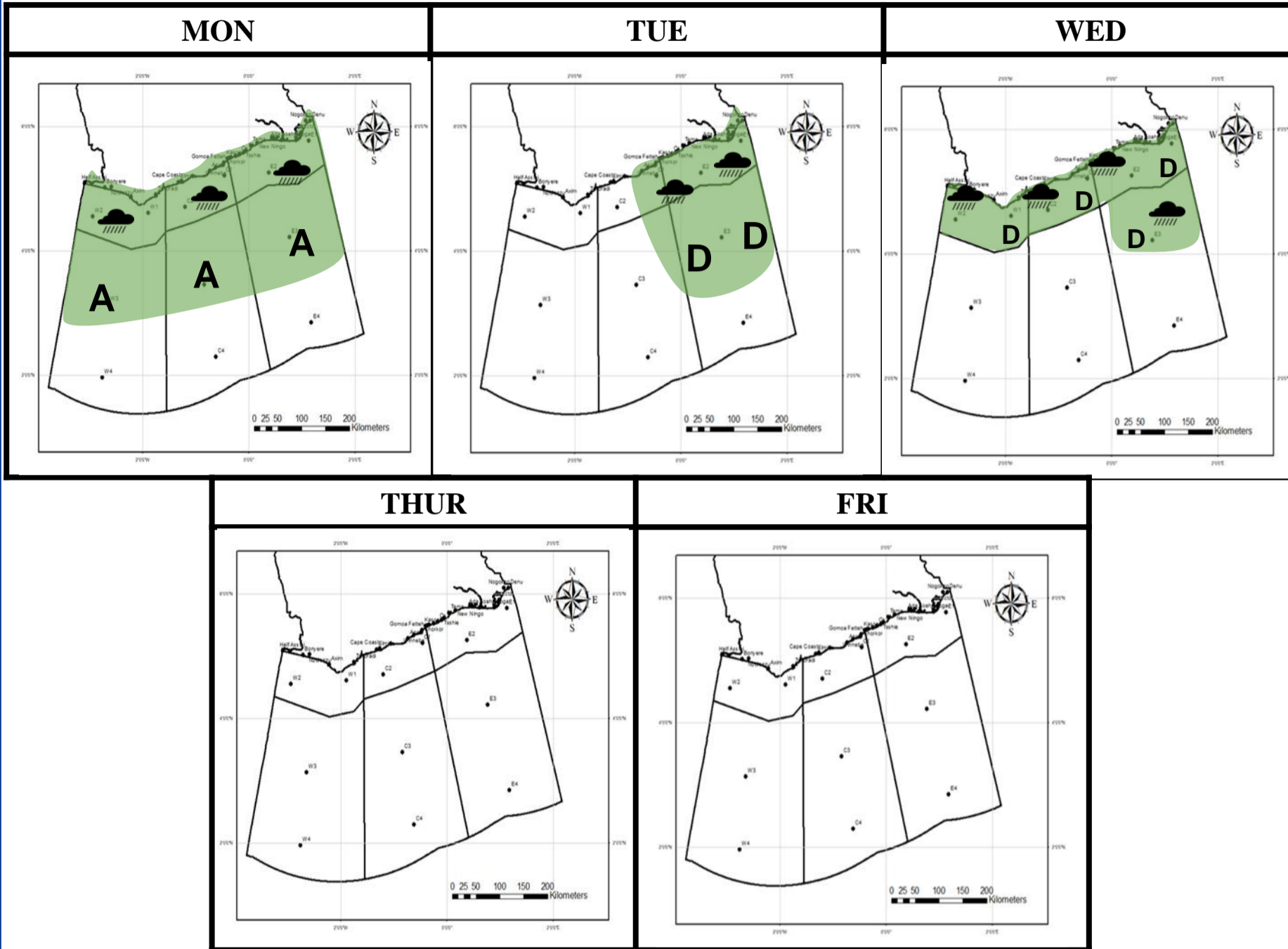

WEATHER SUMMARY

The country's maritime zone is forecast to experience variable cloud cover throughout the period, with some sunny intervals in the afternoon. Isolated rainfall of varying intensities and thunderstorms, together with moderate to strong winds, are expected to affect both onshore and certain offshore areas over the week. Sea conditions are expected to remain rough throughout the week.
