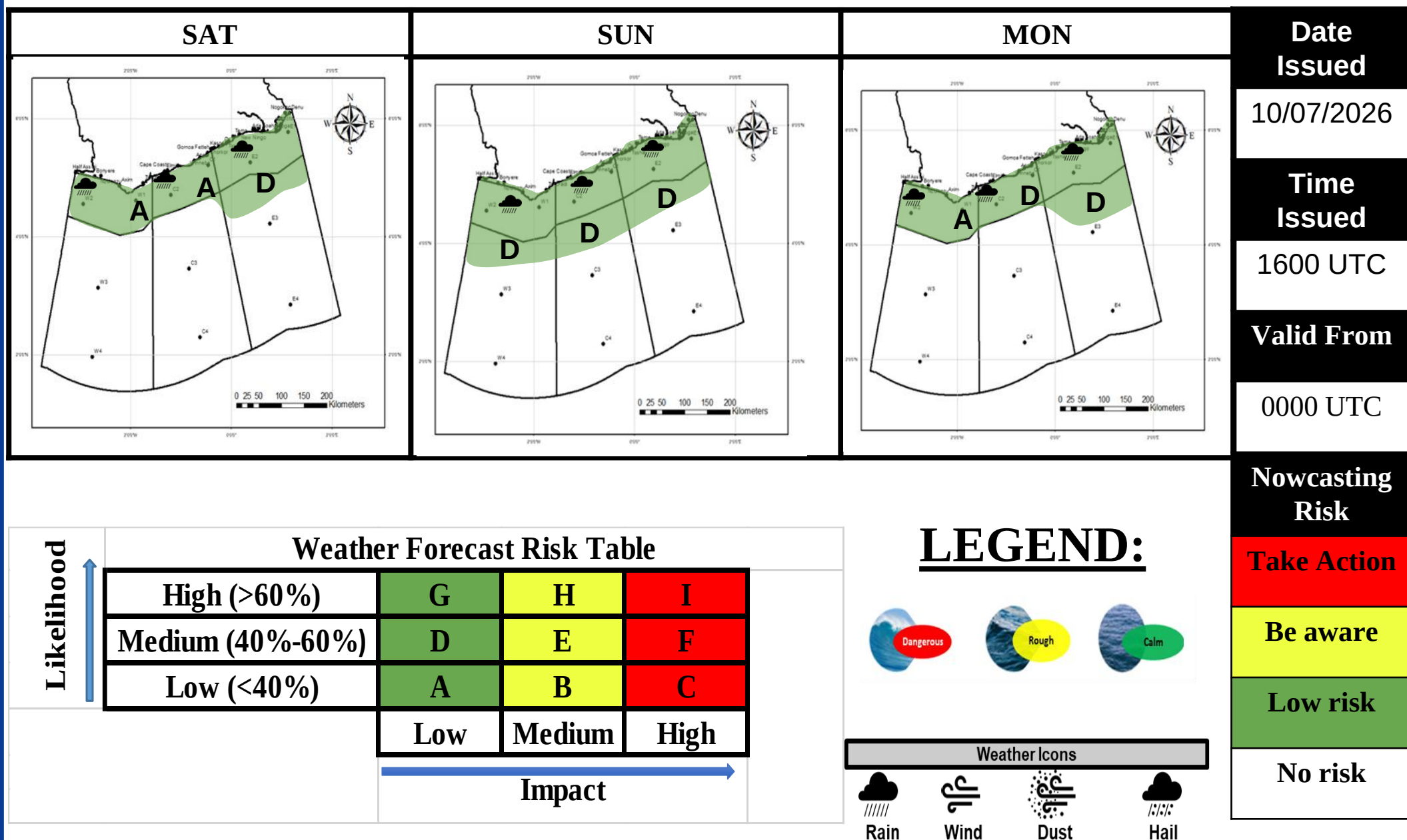

WEATHER SUMMARY
