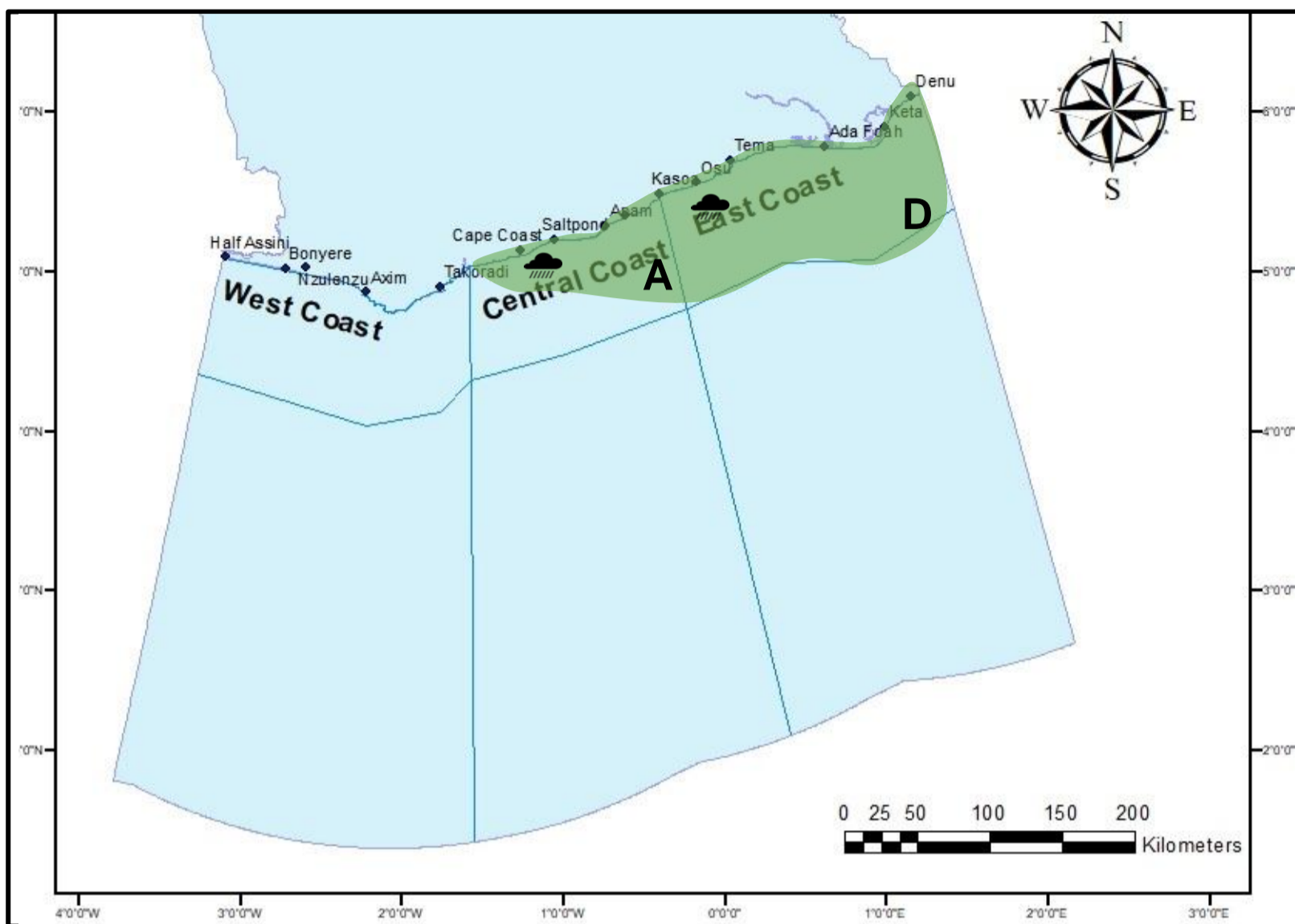

WEATHER SUMMARY: Cloudy conditions are expected to dominate the maritime region throughout the forecast duration, with brief sunny intervals along parts of the coast. There is, however, a 40% probability of isolated slight rain over the eastern and central onshore areas during the afternoon.

NB: Strong winds and rough sea state are expected over some areas of the marine space during the validity period.
