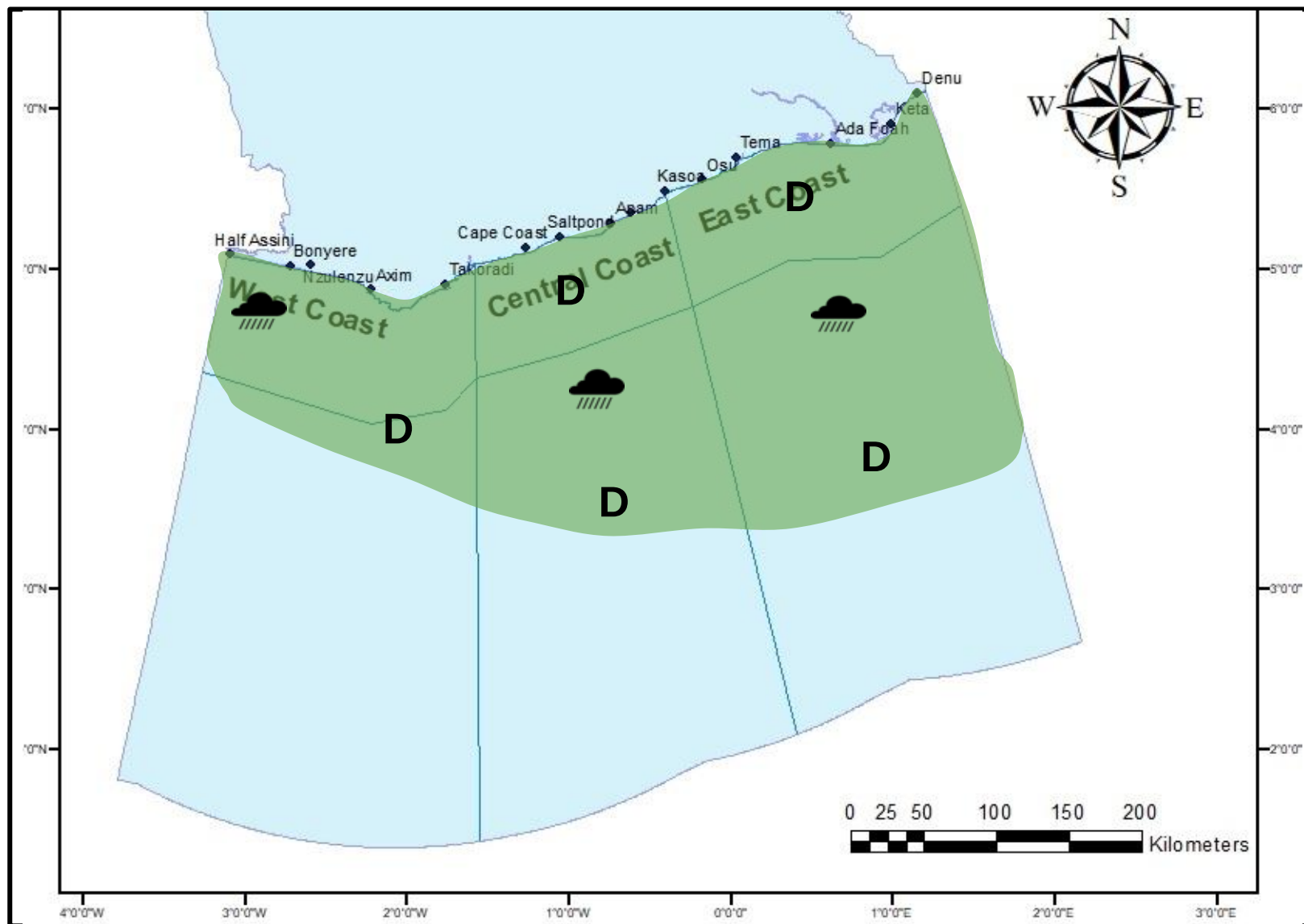

WEATHER SUMMARY: The nation's marine space is expected to experience mostly cloudy weather conditions throughout the forecast period. However, there is a 40-60% chance of isolated thunderstorms and rainfall of varying intensities along onshore and offshore areas from this afternoon into the evening hours.

NB: Strong winds and rough sea states are expected over the maritime region during the validity period.
