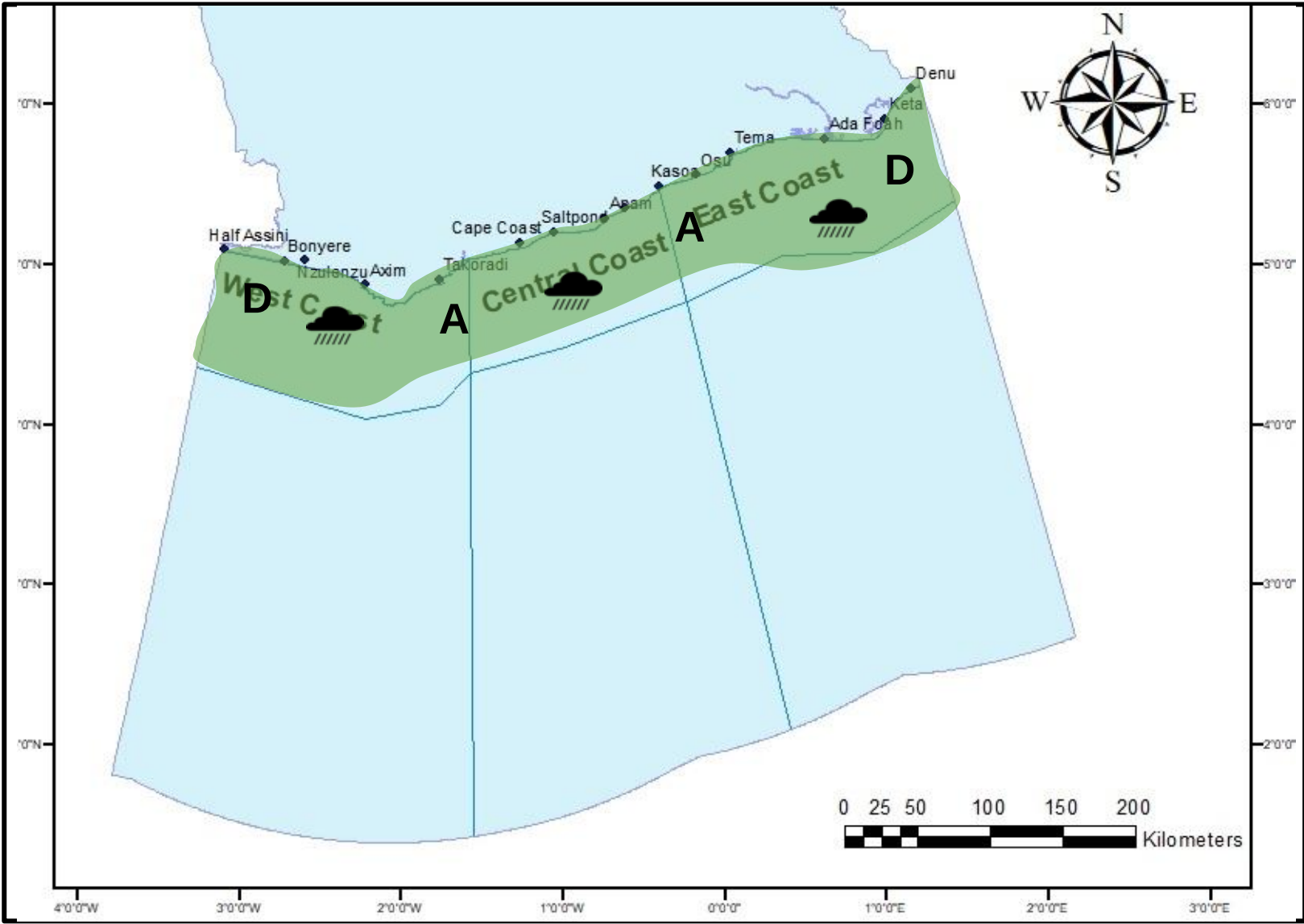

WEATHER SUMMARY: The marine space is expected to experience various cloud amounts at different times during the forecast period, with brief sunshine over the central coastline in the afternoon. Meanwhile, there is a 40% chance of isolated rainfall over onshore areas, dominating the west coast. Due to the rough sea state and gusty winds, sailors are cautioned against sea horses, which are expected to reduce visibility significantly during the forecast duration.
